
Our Solar System

- **7.** Reachers the Earth's surface without burning up
- **9.** Any of the minor bodies in the belt of the same name outside the orbit of Neptune
- **10.** These are mostly located between the orbits of Mars and Jupiter

Down

1. A spherical region that surrounds the solar system and extends almost halfway to the nearest star

- **2.** The largest of the small bodies are located here
- 3. Contains small bodies made mostly of ice
- **4.** Follows a highly elliptical orbit around the Sun
- **5.** Pluto became the first member of the new this new group of solar system bodies
- **6.** These travel at about 52 km/s as measured by a radar on Earth
- **8.** Causes a bright streak of light as it burns up in the Earth's atmosphere
