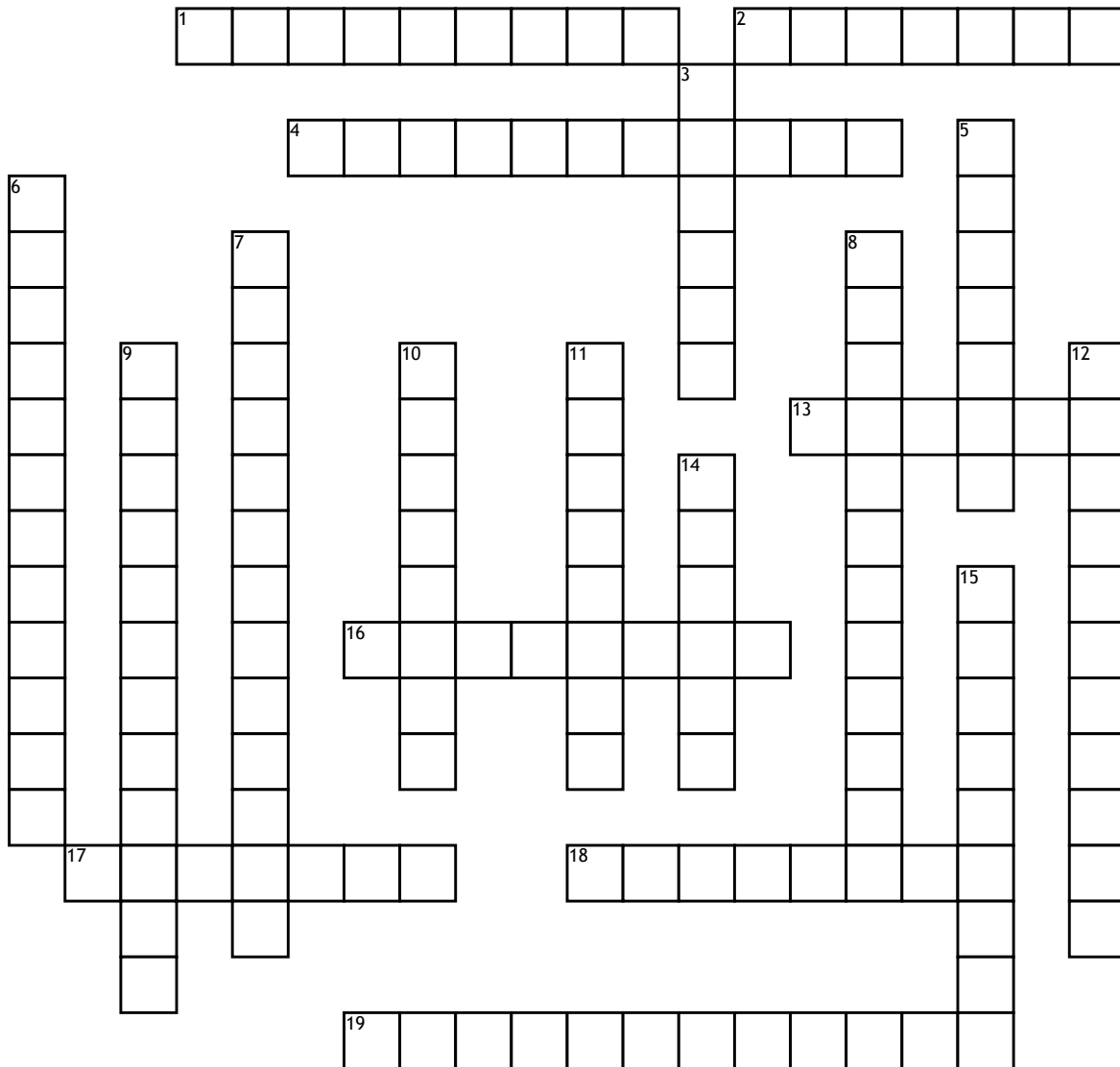


# Outsiders Crossword Puzzle
