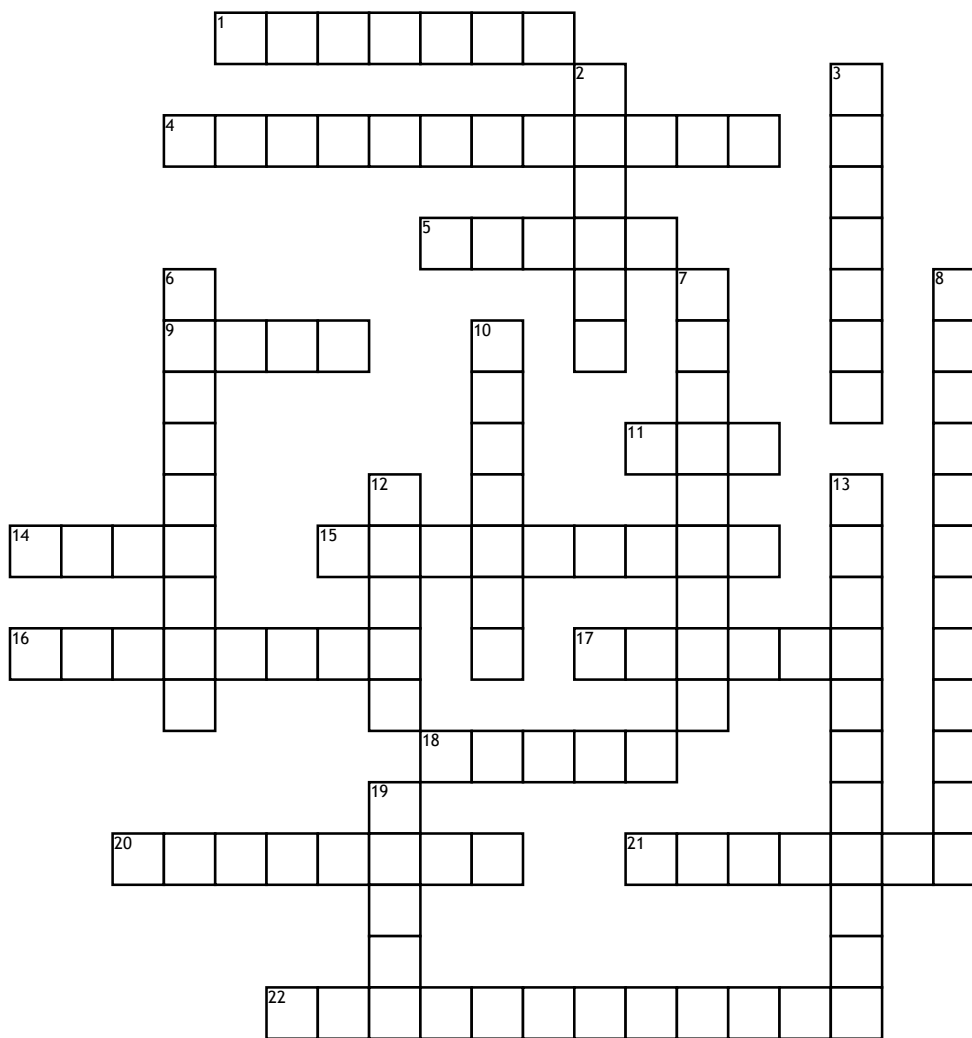


Outsiders Crossword Puzzle
