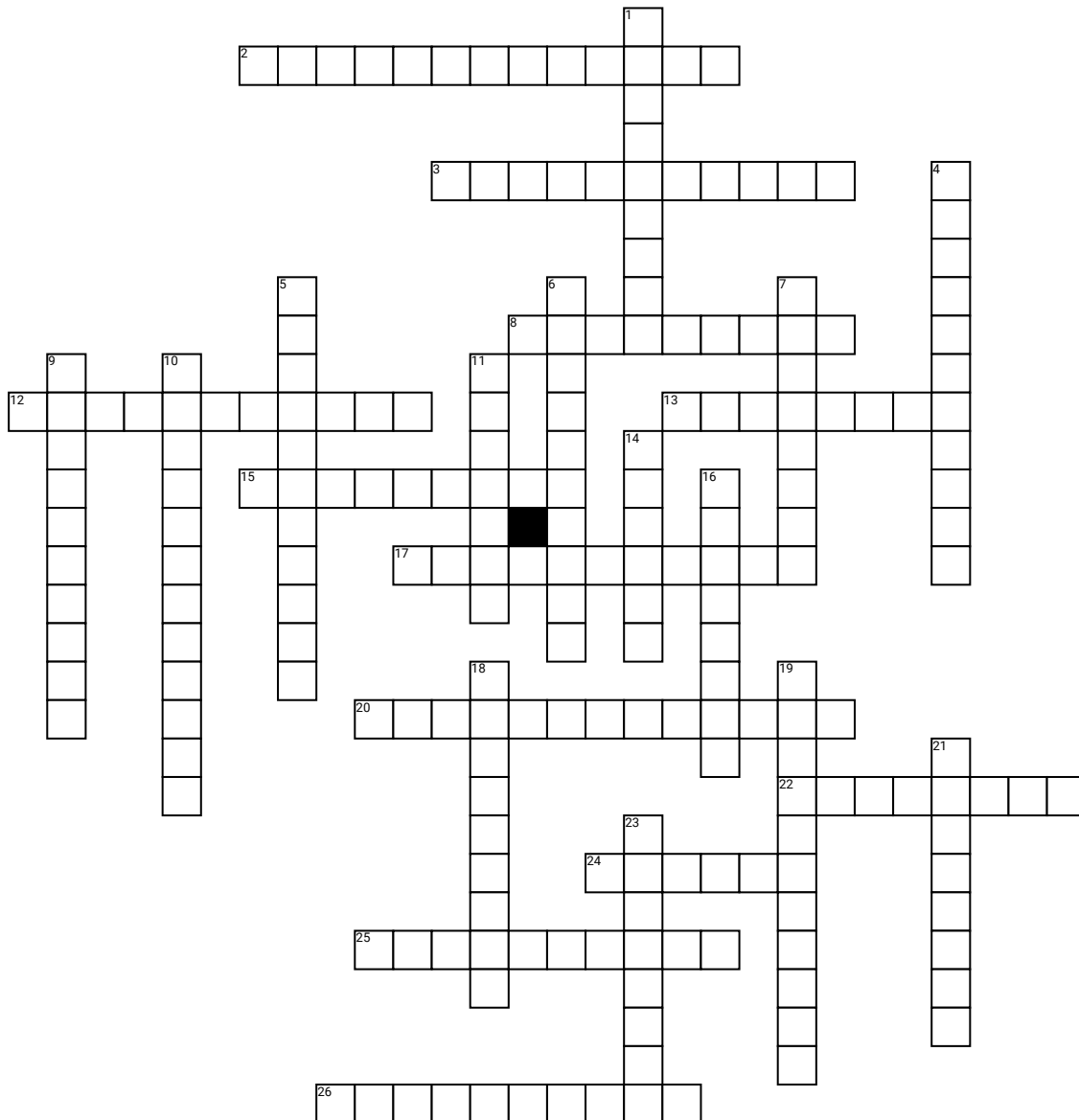


# P1 Drug Card Crossword Puzzle 2021



## Across

2. Drink a full glass of water following administration of chewable tablets  
 3. Dosage form comes in strengths of 100mg and 300mg  
 8. Take immediate-release tablets at regular intervals no sooner than three to four times daily  
 12. Pregnant women should not handle crushed tablets  
 13. Dosage form comes in strengths of 50mg, 100mg, 200mg, and 400mg  
 15. Take 30 minutes before meals  
 17. Dosage forms include chewable tablets, capsules, powder for suspension, and others  
 20. Therapy should be withdrawn slowly to minimize the potential of triggering a seizure

22. This medication can mask hypoglycemic symptoms in diabetic patients

24. Generic name Insulin Glargine

25. Dosage forms include sprinkle capsules, tablets, and ER capsules

26. Dosage forms include tablets, solution, and intenosol solution

## Down

1. Not intended to treat asthmatic attacks, should be taken regularly even when asymptomatic  
 4. Do not take this medication with OTC aspirin or anti-inflammatory medications  
 5. Avoid nonprescription products containing decongestants or sodium salts  
 6. Usually given in early morning. Avoid overexposure to sunlight.  
 7. Avoid prolonged exposure to hot weather

9. Brand name Myrbetriq

10. May increase suicidal thoughts and actions in children, adolescents, and young adults

11. Brand name Prinivil

14. Generic name Pregabalin

16. Dosage forms include tablets, ER tablets, topical gel, and ophthalmic solution

18. Notify physician if unexplained hyperventilation or myalgia

19. Store unopened bottle in refrigerator. Once opened, store in a cool place for up to 6 weeks

21. Rare but serious injuries have occurred due to abnormal sleep behaviors

23. One common adverse drug reaction is upper respiratory infections
