| 3. The "brown" color with a hint of red in the body. Mane and tail match the body color. | C. Blanketed |
| 4. White coat but has a black hide. | D. Black |
| 5. Solid color with lighter spots all over the body. | E. Bay |
| 6. Freckled body. | F. Palomino |
| 7. Pink skin with blue eyes. | G. Sorrel |
| 8. The "blonde" color on the body, mane and tail are usually white. | H. Cremello |
| 9. the "sun-bleached" look on the body with dark legs, face, mane, and tail. | I. Buckskin |
| 10. Has a distinct dorsal stripe that is darker than the rest of it's body. | J. Gray |
| 11. True black hide with no "bleached" spots. | K. Chestnut |
| 12. They have white hair mixed in with their normal base color. | L. Flea-Bitten |
| 13. Large white spot on the horse's rear end. | M. Dapple |
