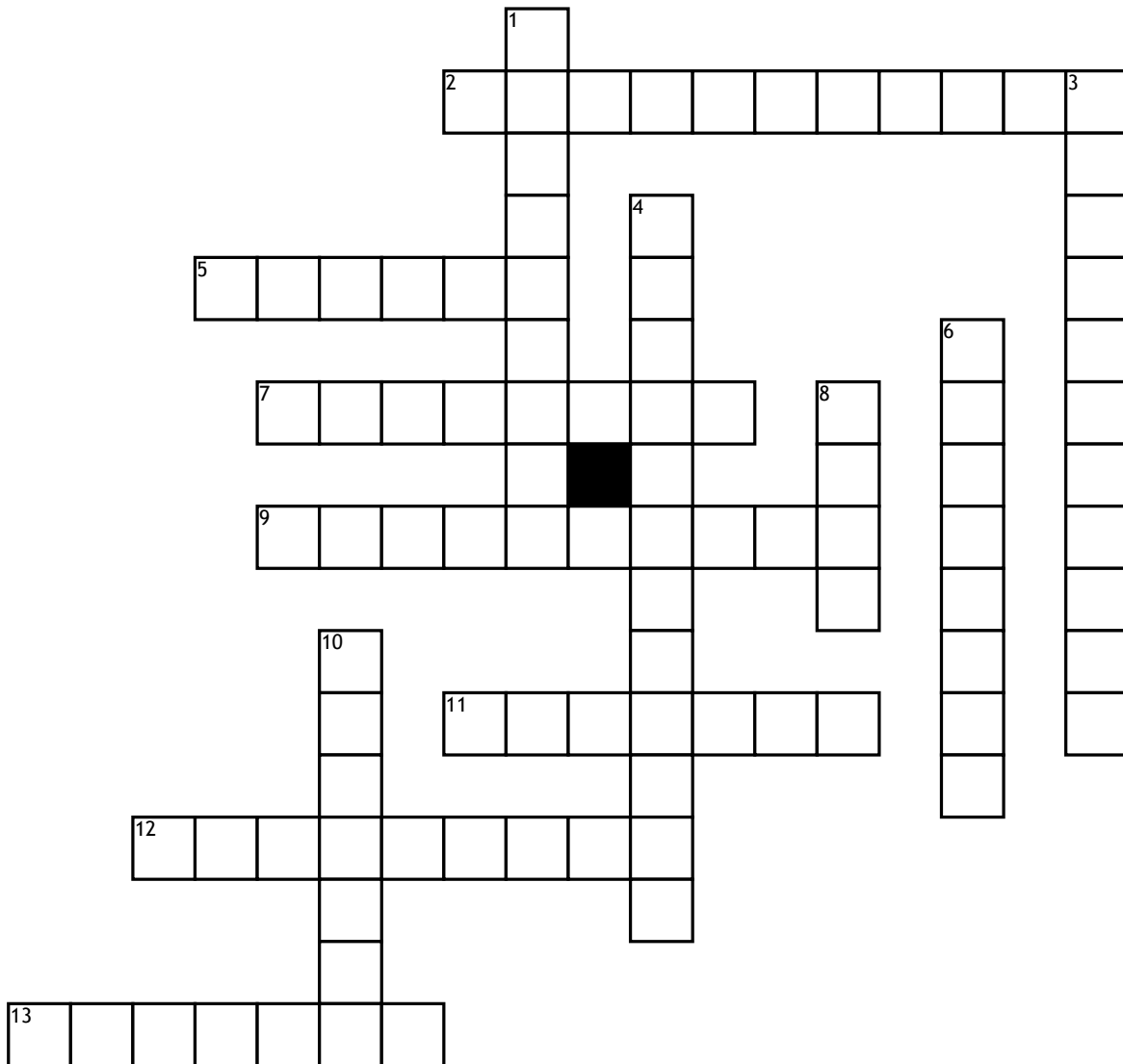


# Paper Towns Crossword Puzzle
