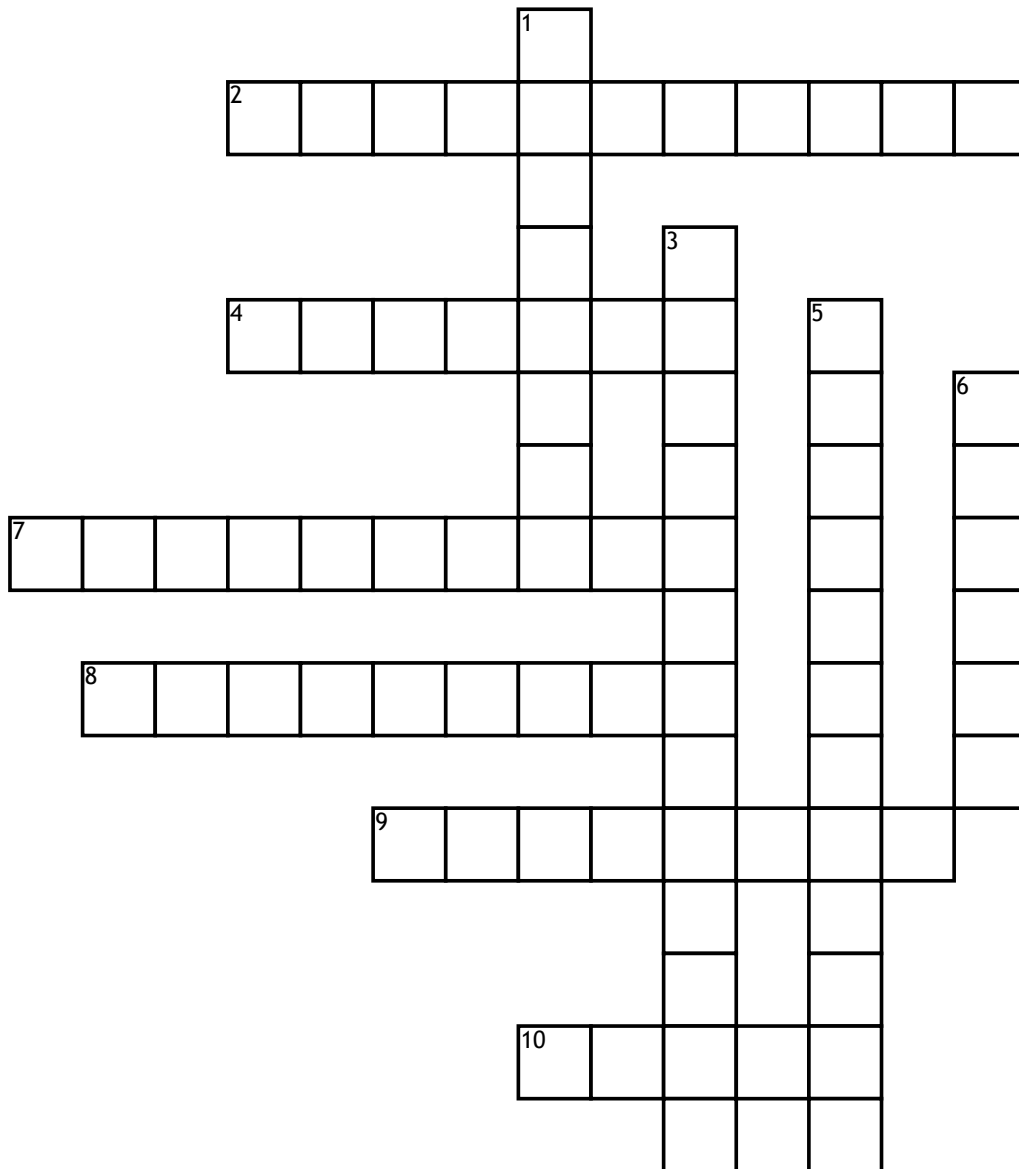

2. Part of a map that is used to show directions on a map.

4. Imaginary line that circles the Earth and divides it into the Northern and Southern Hemispheres.

7. One half of the Earth.

8. The distance of a place, measured in degrees, from the Prime Meridian. These lines run N and S from the Earth's Poles.

9. The four main directions. North, South, East, West.

10. A part of a map that defines the size and distance of places on a map.

1. The distance of a location, measured in degrees, North or South of the Equator. These imaginary lines circle the globe.

3. A line of Longitude that is marked at Zero Degrees. This line originates at Greenwich, England.

5. A person who draws or makes maps.

6. Part of a map that defines the symbols and shapes found on a map. Sometimes called a Map Key.
