

- **2.** Part of a map that is used to show directions on a map.
- **4.** Imaginary line that circles the Earth and divides it into the Northern and Southern Hemispheres.
- 7. One half of the Earth.
- **8.** The distance of a place, measured in degrees, from the Prime Meridian. These lines run N and S from the Earth's Poles.
- **9.** The four main directions. North, South, East, West.

**10.** A part of a map that defines the size and distance of places on a map.

- 1. The distance of a location, measured in degrees, North or South of the Equator. These imaginary lines circle the globe.
- **3.** A line of Longitude that is marked at Zero Degrees. This line originates at Greenwich, England.
- 5. A person who draws or makes maps.
- **6.** Part of a map that defines the symbols and shapes found on a map. Sometimes called a Map Key.
