
Parts of the Sanctuary and Church Etiquette

4. The vestibule, lobby or entrance hall leading into the nave

8. A low rail where communicants kneel; it divides **1.** A gallery for a group of the Nave from the Chancel

9. Raised area, sacred place in the house of worship (place for Holy communion)

10. The passage of the church which connects the entrance hall with the Altar end **11.** The Holy Communion

12. Elevated platform, lectern or stand used in preaching; where ministers sit during worship

2. A container for water to be used in the Sacrament of Baptism

3. The space around the altar of a church enclosed by a railing to pray; it includes the altar, altar rail, pulpit area, podium and choir stand

5. An elevated structure before which prayer may be enacted

6. The altar used to celebrate Holy Communion

7. The essential body of the Church where the congregation is seated; from the narthex to the chancel
