

- **6.** A passage leading upward into the auditorium or stage from the lower floors.
- **8.** A Ramp in the sealing from which technical apparatus can be controlled.
- **9.** The curtains that hide the wings from the rest of the stage
- 11. Where the audience sits.
- **12.** The passage used to move from SL to SR without being seen by the audience.

- **14.** The parts of the stage used by cast and crew, unseen to the audience.
- **15.** The group of musicians sitting in the pit.

- **1.** An extended part of the performance space in front of the proscenium.
- **2.** A type of stage where the audience sits around three sides of the stage.
- **3.** The Arch around the stage in western theatres.

- **4.** The backstage areas to the sides of the stage.
- **5.** A large outdoor performance space
- **7.** A slope in the performance space or auditorium.
- **10.** The curtains that hang from the top of the stage to hide the lighting bars.
- 13. A theatre in the round
