## Pectoral Girdle and Upper Limbs



## Across

3. generally triangular, commonly called with "wings" and located on the shoulder blades
4. pyramidal on the sternal end which attaches to the manubrium. Located on the collarbone
5. bones of the fingers and each hand contain
6. Located on the upper part of the fingers
7. process of the ulna that forms the outer bump of the elbow and fits into the fossa of the humerus. Located in the elbow
8. bears the styloid process and attachment for the ligaments of the wrist. Located on the lateral, distal end of the ulna
9. the medial bone and articulates with the radius at the radial notch. Located in the forearm
10. proximal end is the rounded head which fits into the glenoid cavity. Located on the upper arm 16. side of the forearm and the flattened head pivots with the capitulum of the humerus. Located on the forearm
11. cylindrical which articulates with the capitulum of the humerus. Located on the lateral side of the elbow
12. enlarged end of the spine of the scapula and articulates with the clavicle at the acromioclavicular joint. Located on the shoulder blade.
13. spool shaped and articulates with the ulna. Located on the articular surface of the elbow joint
14. rounded and articulates with the radius of the forearm. Located on the anterior surface of the distal humerus
15. anterior and depression that receives the coronoid process of the ulna when the arm is flexed. Located at the end of the humerus just above the trochlea

## Down

1. posterior side and depression that receives the olecranon of the ulna when the forearm is extended. Located at the point of the elbow
2. bones of the palm and numbered 1-5 from the thumb side of the hand toward the little finger. Located on lower part of fingers
3. oval eminence on the medial side of the radius distal to the neck. Located at the upper left of the radius
4. anterior surface and serves as attachment point for the upper limb muscles. Located below the lateral fourth of the clavicle
5. separated by the shaft
6. runs across the posterior surface and has a flattened body with 2 processes. Located in the center of the back
7. triangular eminence projecting forward from the upper and front part of the ulna. Located at the superior aspect of the ramus
8. eight small bones that make up the wrist that connects the hand to the forearm. Located on the hand
9. consists of 2 anterior clavicles and 2 posterior scapulae. Located on the shoulder
