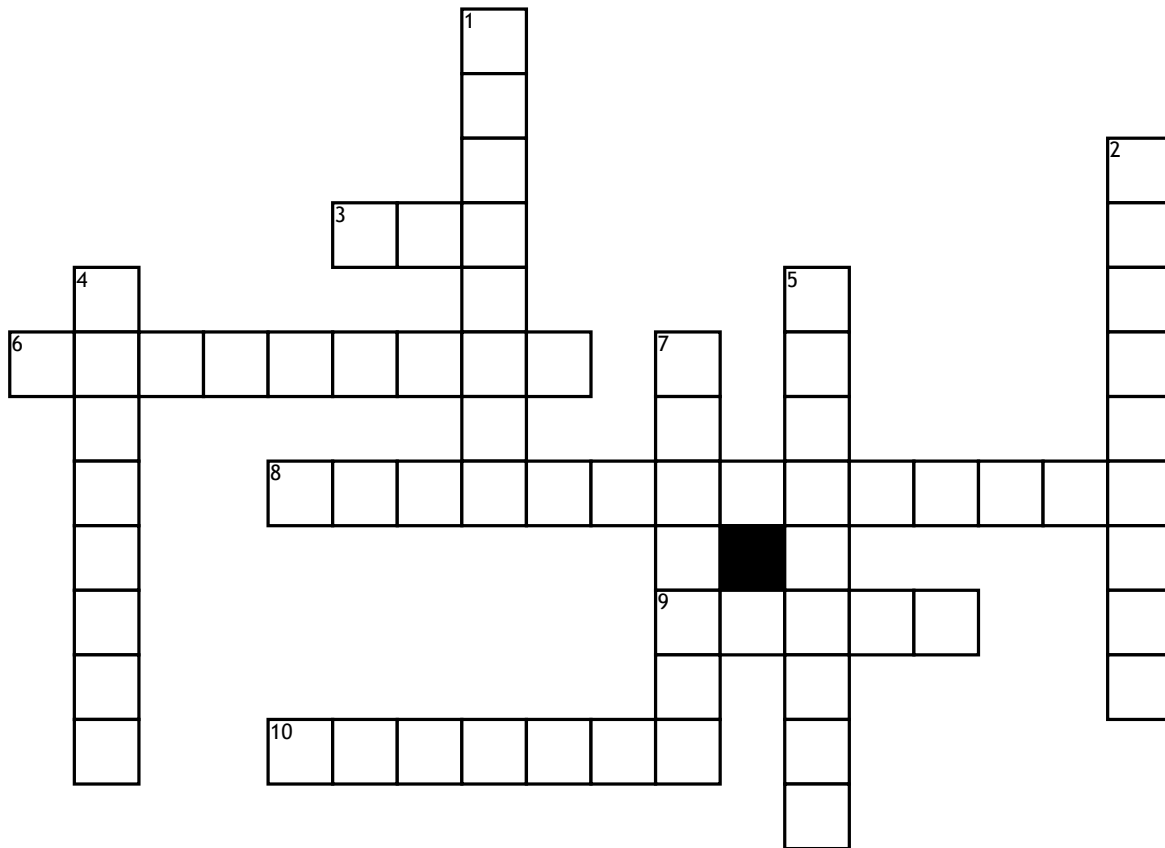

## Across

3. Administered to patients with hyperthyroidism, sometimes prior to surgery. (trade name)  
 6. Antidiabetic drug for managing type 2 DM and is also used off-label to treat women with polycystic ovary syndrome. (generic name)  
 8. Synthetic corticosteroid that is the drug of choice for treating adrenocortical insufficiency, and also used for inflammation and allergic disorders. (generic name)  
 9. Causes arterioles in the nasal passages to constrict, producing a drying of the mucous membranes. (trade name)  
 10. Used to control acute symptoms of DI in patients who have insufficient ADH secretion. (trade name)

## Down

1. Short-acting insulin with an onset action of 30 to 60 minutes, promoting the entry of glucose into cells. (trade name)  
 2. Rapid onset inhaler used to relieve the bronchospasm of asthma. (generic name)  
 4. Used to treat symptoms of allergies and the common cold, as well as to treat rashes and severe allergic reactions. (trade name)  
 5. Used for replacement therapy in patients with low thyroid function. (trade name)  
 7. Intranasal corticosteroid used to treat allergic rhinitis and is sprayed twice in each nostril. (trade name)
