
## Pin Curl Construction



## **Across**

- **6.** Curls formed in the opposite direction
- **7.** Is placed directly on the base of the curl and allows minimum mobility.
- 8. What is the second part of a pin curl?
- **9.** What is the third and final part of a pin curl?
- **10.** Pin curls places immediately behind or below a ridge to form a wave

## **Down**

- 1. Permits medium movement, the curl is placed half off the base.
- **2.** Allows for the greatest mobility, the curl is place completely off base.
- **3.** Forcing the hair between the thumb and the back of the comb to create tension.
- **4.** Curls formed in the same direction as the movement of the hands of a clock?
- 5. What are the first part of a pin curl?
