

- 8. the upper angle between the leaf or flower stem and the stalk of the plant
- **9.** a terminal plant bud that produces stem and leaf growth
- **10.** one of the major root systems, consisting of many fine hairlike roots
- **13.** large main root of the system; usually has a few or no branch roots
