

- **2.** Intolerant of frost and cold. Required warm air temperature and soil to germinate
- **3.** Hybrid chosen as a superior performer by a non-profit organization sponsored by the American seed trade
- **4.** Uses a tube or hose usually at low pressure, to drive water directly to a row
- **9.** Water-soluble plastic tapes
- **16.** A garden planted in late summer and harvested in the fall before frost
- **17.** The average date of the last 32 degrees freeze in the spring

- **18.** Materials derived from living organisms
- **19.** Covering the soil around vegetable plants with natural or synthetic materials to moderate temperature
- **20.** Withstand light frosts, can germinate in cool soils

- 1. Germinate well in cool soil and can withstand light frosts
- **5.** Materials from plants or animanute
- **6.** The filling of trenches between rows with water
