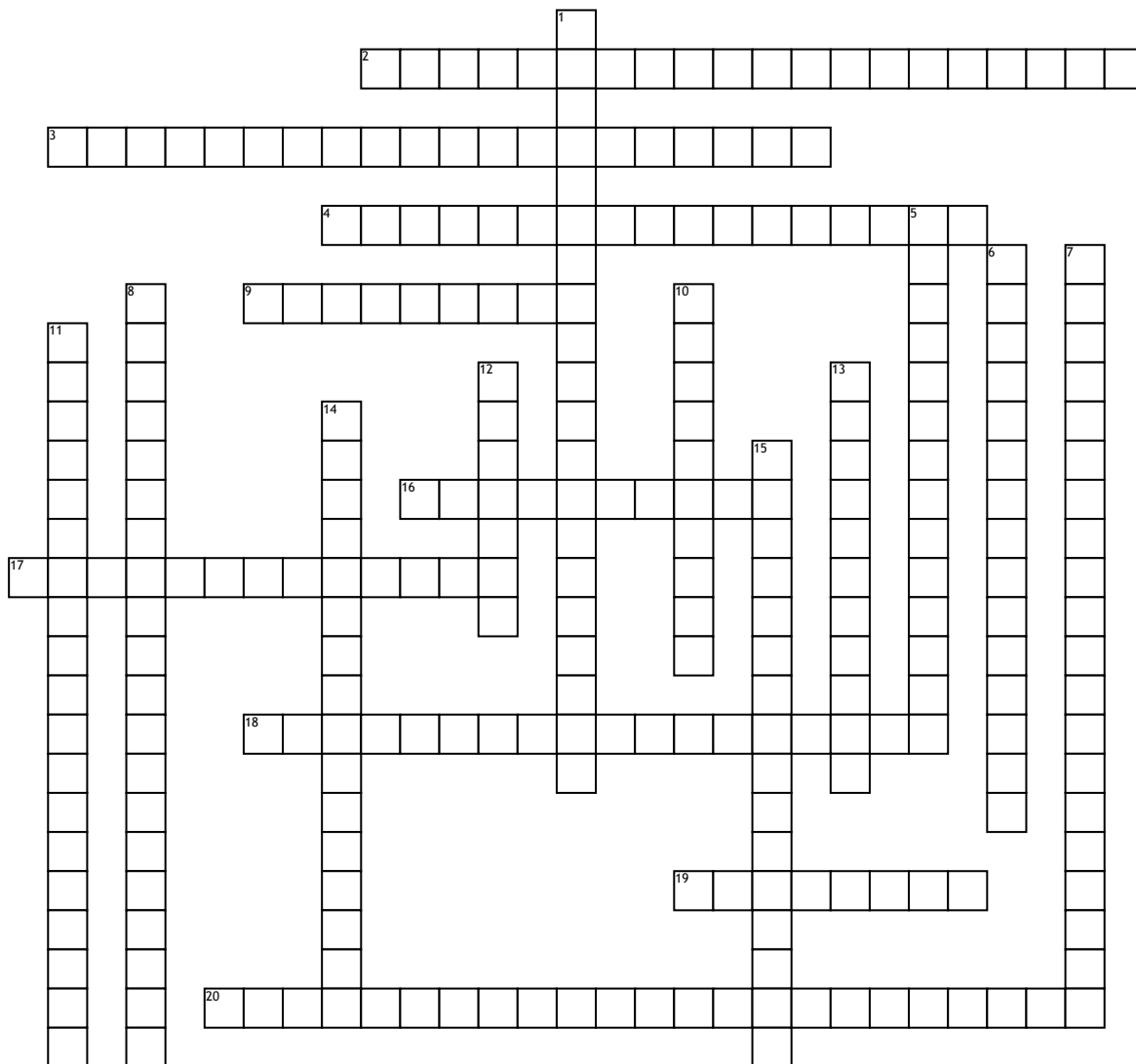


# Planting and Maintaining a Vegetable Garden



## Across

2. Intolerant of frost and cold. Required warm air temperature and soil to germinate  
 3. Hybrid chosen as a superior performer by a non-profit organization sponsored by the American seed trade  
 4. Uses a tube or hose usually at low pressure, to drive water directly to a row  
 9. Water-soluble plastic tapes  
 16. A garden planted in late summer and harvested in the fall before frost  
 17. The average date of the last 32 degrees freeze in the spring

18. Materials derived from living organisms

19. Covering the soil around vegetable plants with natural or synthetic materials to moderate temperature  
 20. Withstand light frosts, can germinate in cool soils

## Down

1. Germinate well in cool soil and can withstand light frosts  
 5. Materials from plants or animals  
 6. The filling of trenches between rows with water

7. Chemical compounds not produced from living organisms

8. Germinate and grow only in warm soil  
 10. Seed produced by crossing two parental lines  
 11. Withstand freezing temperatures and hard frosts without injury  
 12. Seeds are planted one at a time  
 13. Seeds are planted in groups of usually two or three in a hill  
 14. Injured or killed by frost  
 15. Human-made materials
