

- **5.** Secondary growth increase in width of the stem to support the growing plants
- 9. Fruits have foul odor
- **11.** Complex mixture of sand, silt, clay, air and bits of decaying animal and plant tissues
- **12.** Conducts water from roots to leaves
- **14.** Found mostly in dicots, one thick vertical root with many lateral roots that emanate from it
- **16.** The male part of the flower
- 17. Produces sperm

- **18.** Lack vessels for conducting water and food throught the plant

<u>Down</u>

- 1. Area where cells are growing and maturing
- 2. Require water for fertilization
- **3.** Begins formation of pollen tube that extends into style
- 4. Loss of water through leaves, loss of water is replaced by water drawn into the leaf through xylem vessels

- **6.** First appeared in fossil record about 425 million years ago
- 7. Just under the epidermis, absorb light that enters the leaf
- **8.** Outer layer of root made of epidermal cells from whixh root hairs extend out the soil root hair provide a large surface area for the cells to absorb enough water to support entire plant
- **10.** Nitrogen, phosphorus, potassium, magnesium, and calcium
- **13.** Vascular bundles scattered around the stem, ground tissue between the bundles
- **15.** Includes mosses
