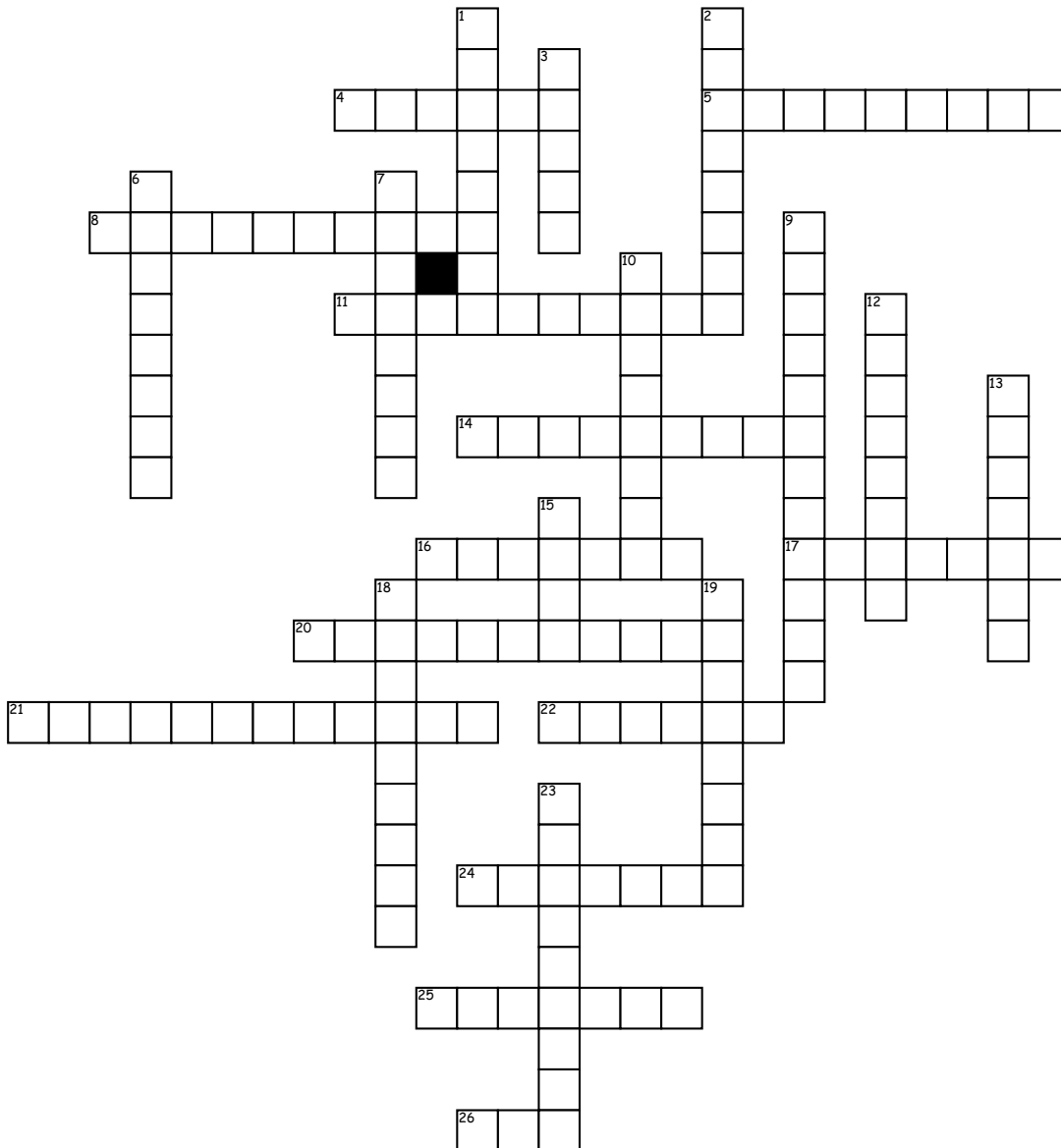

- 4. a group of consecutive lines in a poem that form a single unit; similar to a paragraph
- 5. the repetition of vowel sounds in words that are close together
- 8. this kind of symbolism represents something besides the obvious
- 11. repeating a word, phrase, line, or stanza multiple times within a poem
- 14. Realistic or true, this poem tells a story
- 16. This poem is made up of 2 lines whose last words rhyme; it is often silly
- 17. 3-lined poem with a rhyming pattern (AAA; ABA)
- 20. AABBA is known as .....
- 21. "buzz", "rustle", "thud", "zoom"

- 22. Tells a story in short stanzas; sometimes set to music
- 24. the voice talking to us in a poem
- 25. this kind of symbolism means exactly what it means
- 26. This famous poet wrote "The Raven"

- 1. this poem is made up of words that are placed in such a way that they make the shape of the object
- 2. a poem with 4-lines (stanzas) following a rhyme scheme of AABB or ABAB
- 3. a 3-line poem containing 17 syllables; from Japan
- 6. A 5-line poem in which each line follows a specific rule

- 7. a short, humorous poem with 5 lines; usually silly!
- 9. the repetition of consonant sounds in words that are close together
- 10. the words form the shape of a diamond
- 12. 1st letters of each line are aligned vertically to form a word
- 13. language that appeals to the senses
- 15. A long poem based on historical facts
- 18. an exaggeration
- 19. "Johnny has a heart of gold" is an example of this
- 23. poetry without meter or rhyme scheme
