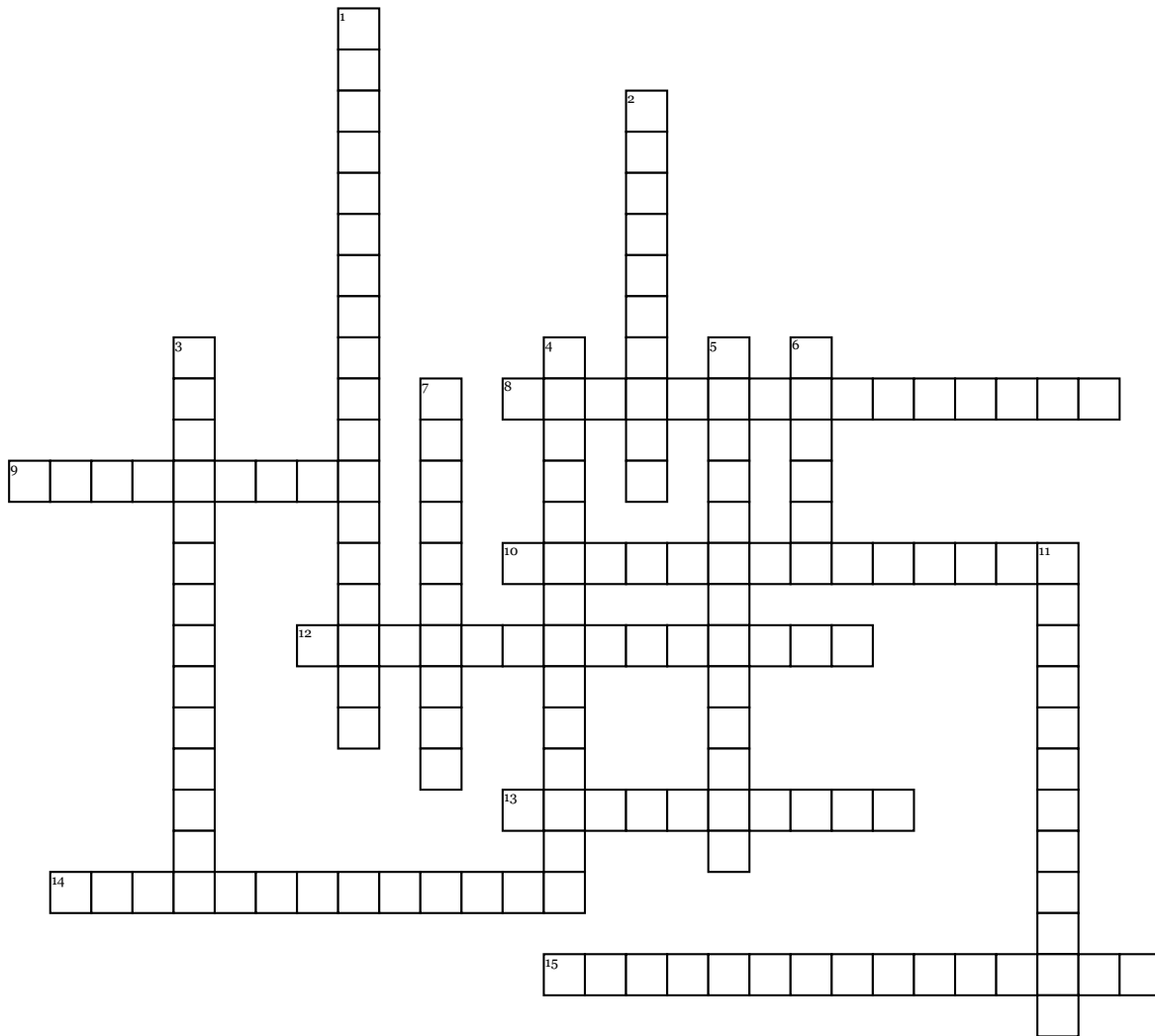

- 9.** General agreement among group on fundamental matters, broad agreement on public question
- 10.** Is a political situation, especially in the context of a two - party system, as is the case for countries such as the U.S., in which opposing political parties find common ground through compromise in theory
- 12.** Achieve (a result) by manipulating the boundaries of an electoral constituency

- 13.** Pressures as public official from members of an interest group on the people at large

- 14.** A party nominally election in which only declared party members can vote

- 15.** The regularly scheduled election at which voters make a final selection of office holder

- 1.** Is a diverse one, where the people in it relieve all kinds of different things and each other's beliefs even when they don't match their own

- 2.** A judicial order that restrains a person from beginning or continuing an action threatening or invading the legal right of another

- 3.** An organized group that tries to influence the government to adopt certain policies or measures

- 4.** A group of persons who seek to control government

- 5.** An election held within a party to pick the party's candidates for the general election

- 6.** As nominating device a group of like-minded people who meet to select the candidate
