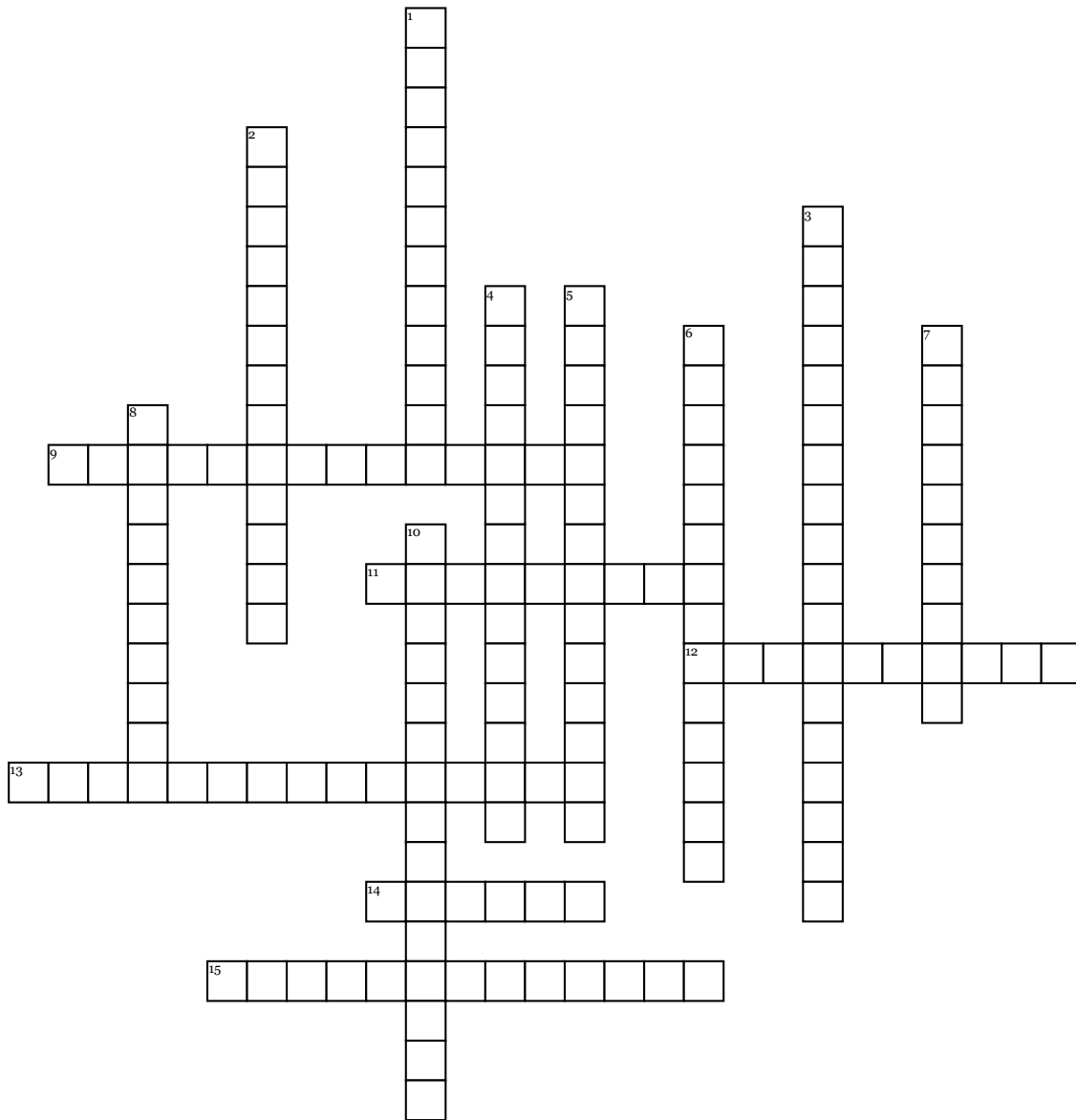


# Political behavior
