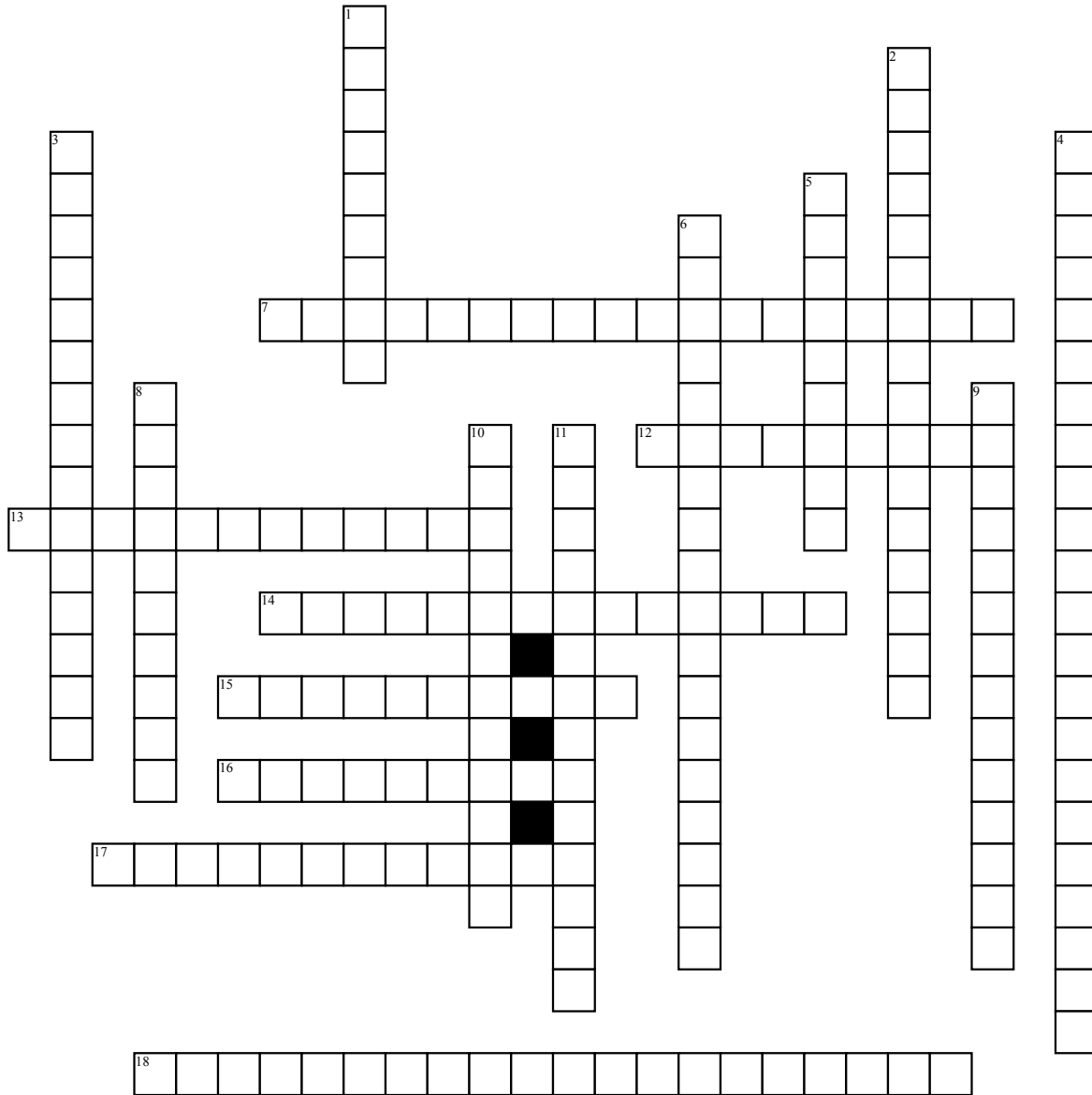


Political parties
