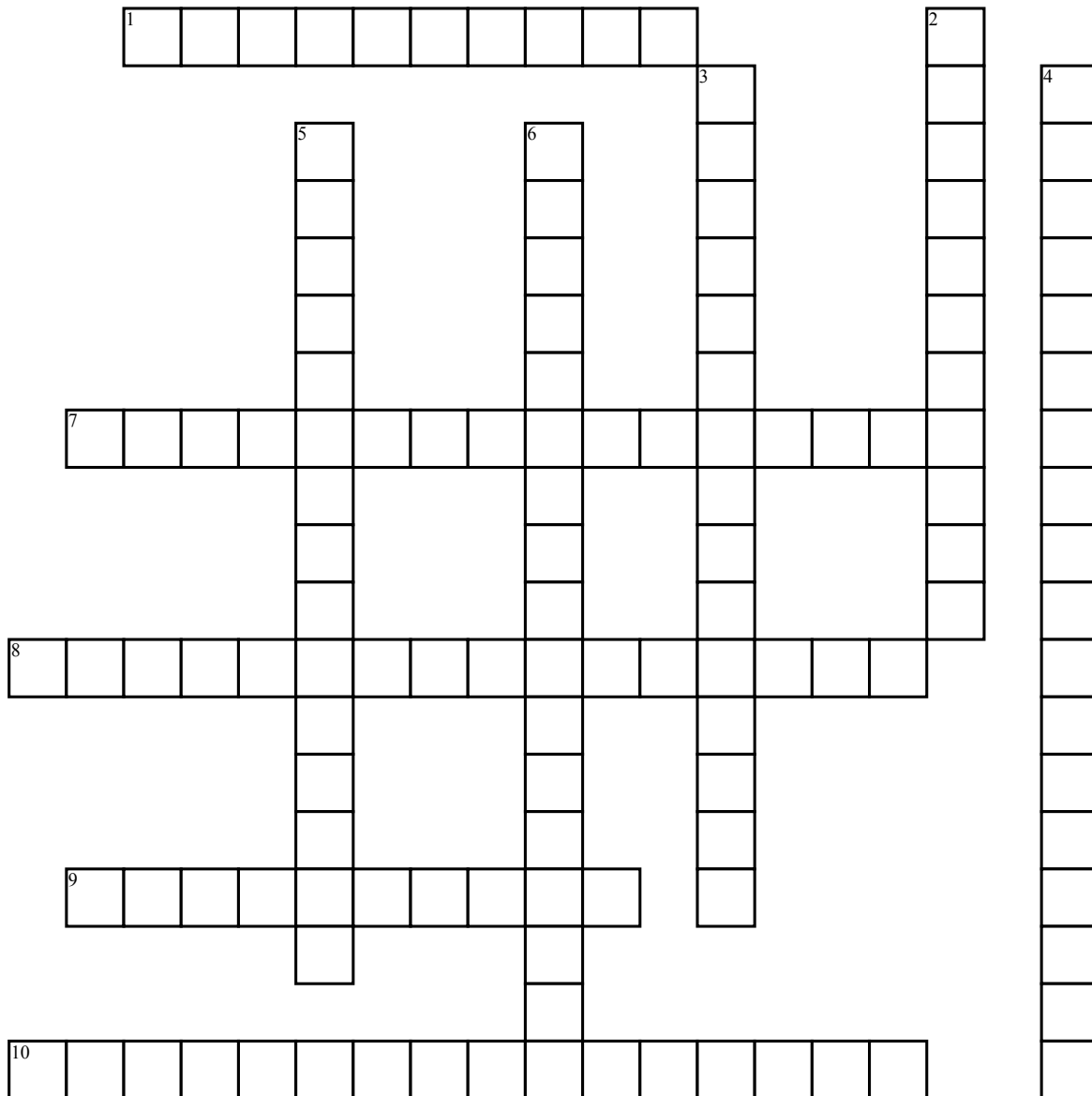


Population Dynamics
