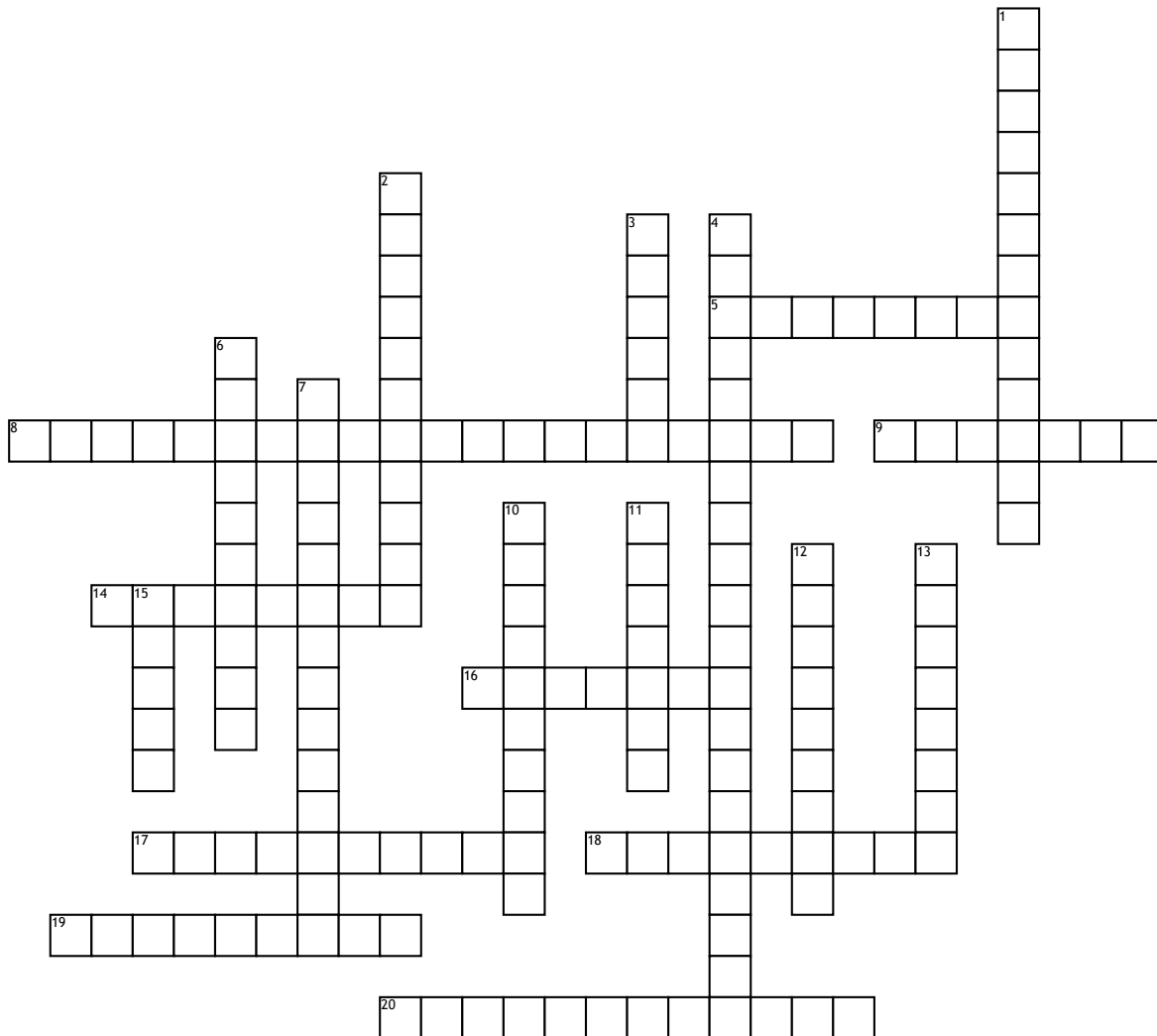


Porifera/Cnidarians

- 8. primary organ of digestion and circulation
- 9. noun: habitat; plural noun: habitats the natural home or environment of an animal, plant, or other organism
- 14. one of the small, hard calcareous or siliceous bodies that serve as skeletal elements
- 16. fixed in one place, immobile
- 17. a specialized cell containing a barbed or venomous thread

- 18. an animal of the metazoa division
- 19. an explosive cell containing one giant secretory organelle
- 20. feeding by filtering our plankton or nutrients

- 1. a form of asexual reproduction wherein a parent breaks into fragments that grow into a new organism
- 2. flattened cells containing many granules capable of contracting
- 3. a form of cnidarian shaped like an umbrella
- 4. two word naming, made by Carolus Linnaeus

- 6. a flagellated cell with a collar of protoplasm at the base of the flagellum
- 7. symmetry around a central axis
- 10. capable of developing into other types of cells, especially reproductive cells
- 11. a form of asexual reproduction in which a new organism develops from an outgrowth

- 13. domain, kingdom, phylum, class, order, family, genus, species
- 15. a solitary or colonial sedentary form of coelenterate such as a sea anenome
