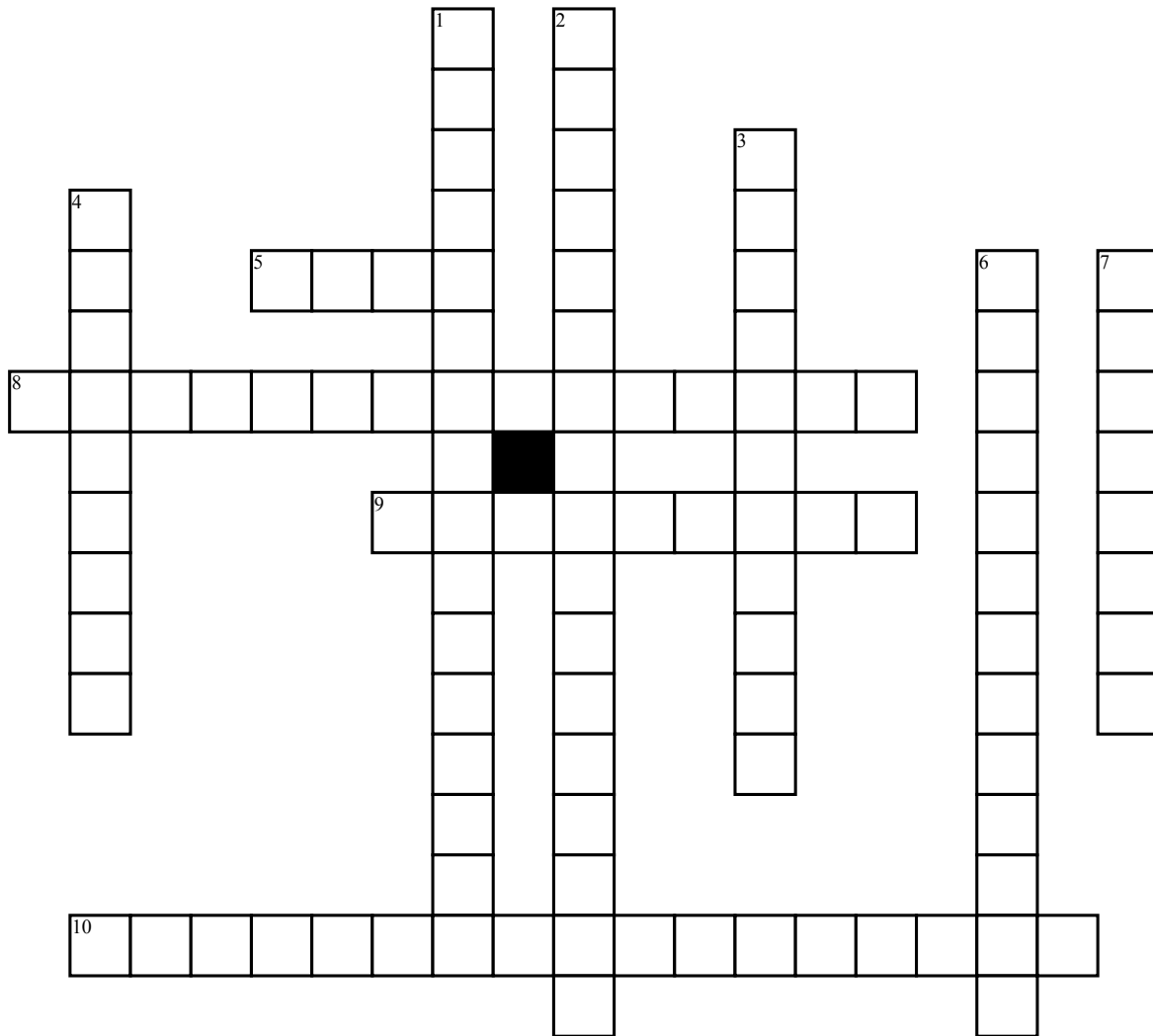


Postwar Trials Crossword

- 1. The action by Germany that began World War II in 1939. Germany invaded Poland

- 2. Nazi Party and German government officials gathered at a villa in the Berlin suburb of Wannsee to discuss and coordinate the implementation of what they called the "Final Solution of the Jewish Question."
- 3. A former federation of communist republics that occupied the northern half of Asia and part of eastern Europe; capital, Moscow
- 4. A war fought from 1939 to 1945 between the Axis powers — Germany, Italy, and Japan
- 6. refer to their plan to annihilate the Jewish people
- 7. specific term, referring to violent crimes committed against groups with the intent to destroy the existence of the group
