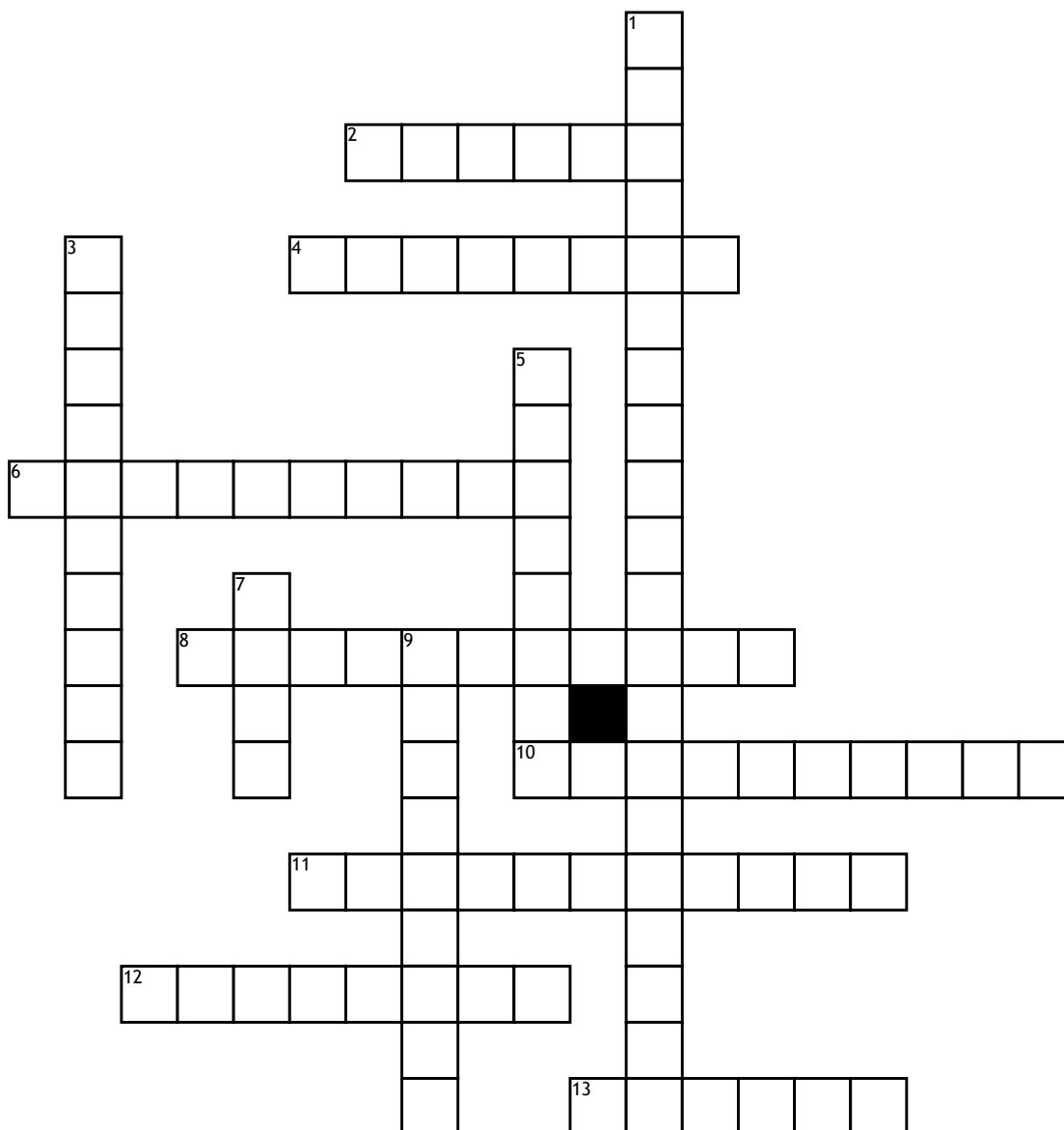


Presentation Basics

2. repeat steps 4-9 as needed to fine-tune the presentation
 4. an object that is actually stored in the container (presentation file) rather than pointing to a linked document or file somewhere else
 6. presenting data in more than one medium, such as combining text, graphics, animation, video and sound
 8. To train, present information, emphasize key points, or explain procedures

10. a collection of frames on a piece of paper used to determine the number of slides needed and organize the content of the presentation
 11. control the flow of information
 12. the timing, and speech patterns (tone, speed, transition phrases)
 13. appropriate for the purpose of the presentation and templates may be used

1. a program used to create slide shows or multimedia presentations
