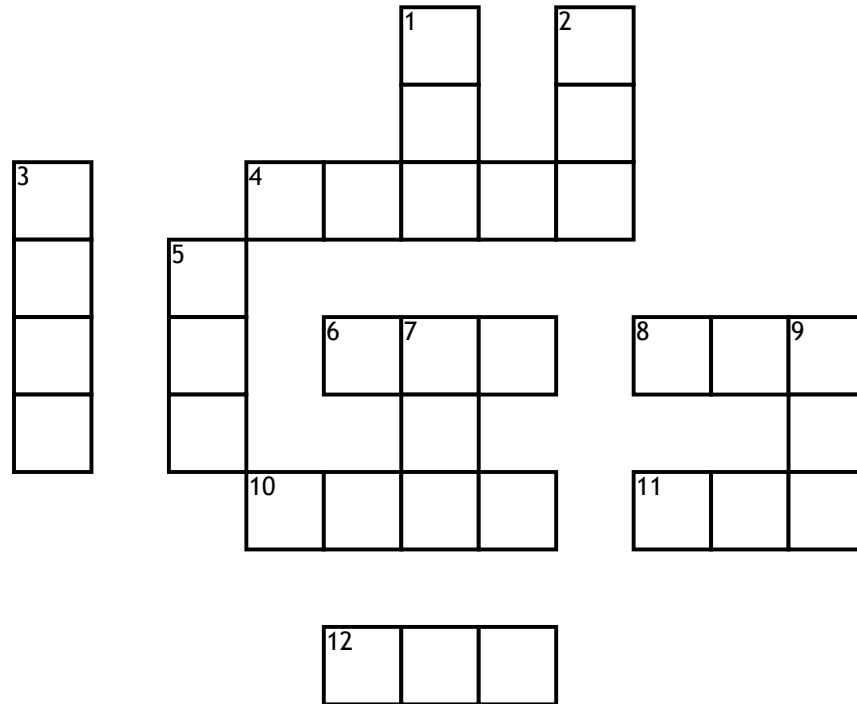


# Prevention Alphabet Soup: What do all the Acronym

- 4. Alcohol, Drug and Mental Health Board of Franklin County that grant funds the Prevention Program services.
- 6. Family Interaction Group a wrap around program that allows parents and their children 7-12 to communicate about feelings and the impact of addiction of the family while increasing parenting skills through Parenting Wisely
- 8. You're Extra Special targets ages 7-12 to build coping and resiliency skills for children impacted by addiction and adverse events
- 10. Application Purpose Pride Success Support works with Recreation and Parks to target at risk young adults to increase community support while decreasing alcohol and drug use and violence.

- 11. Columbus City Schools where families can find our prevention program groups

- 1. Children of Alcoholics and Addicts
- 2. Columbus Public Health houses the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Programs
- 3. Substance Abuse General Education an intensive intervention for those 18 and older that do not meet a treatment diagnosis but need further education to understand the impact of high risk alcohol and drug choices.
- 5. Leadership Resiliency Program targets middle and high school youth to increase protective factors while decreasing high risk choices especially around alcohol and drug use.

- 7. Immigrant Women's Program provides outreach and small groups to the Latina Women of Franklin County to educate them on topics of health, resources, and build peer leaders in that community
- 9. Saving Ourselves targets ages 14-19 to decrease rates of teen STI and HIV rates, teen pregnancy, and increase awareness of how alcohol and drugs impacts healthy relationships
