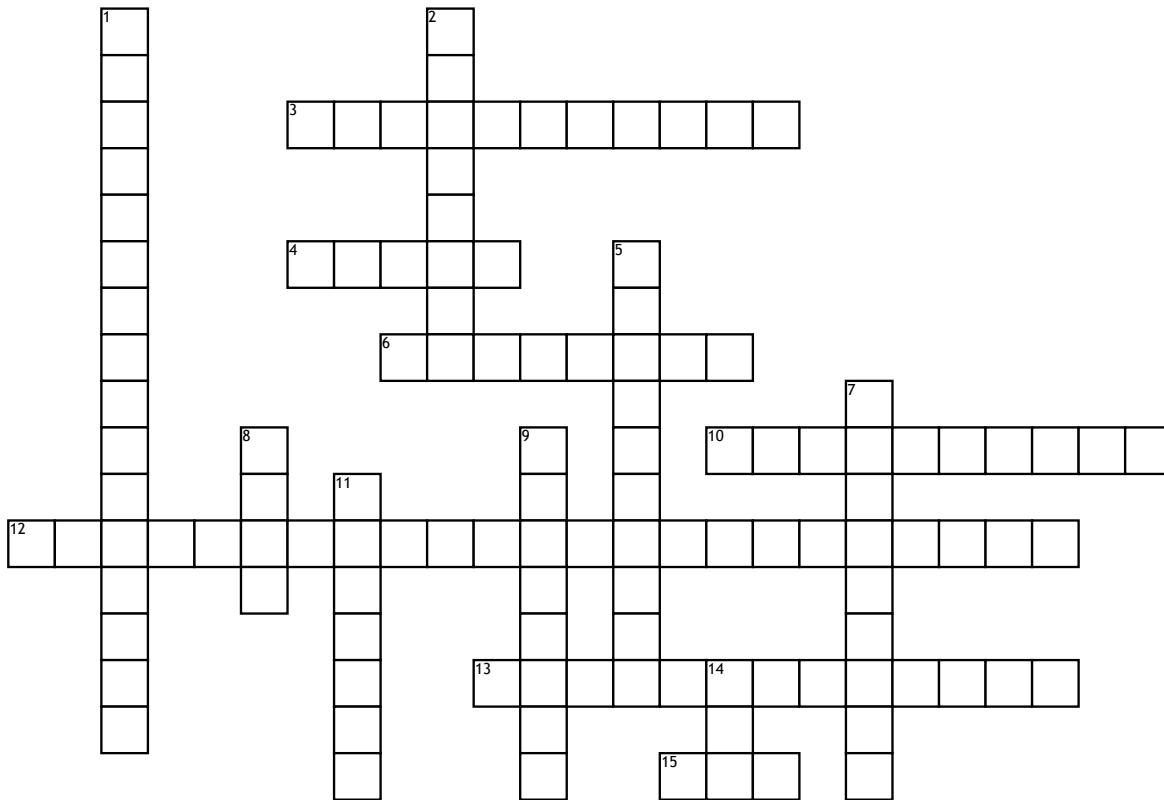


# Primary Care Terms and Definition Crossword

**4.** The fee that is paid with every visit; can be different depending on PCP, Specialist, ED visit, UCC, visit, etc. This is determined by insurance.

**6.** The most important identifier (#) for billing and linking the person to their insurance policy.

**10.** A set amount that needs to be met before insurance will start paying

**12.** An organization that processes insurance claims or certain aspects of employee benefit plans for a separate entity.

**13.** Insurances that partner with certain health care networks, that only allow their customers to receive services through that organization.

**15.** A healthcare provider( physician) who is responsible for overseeing all health aspects for their patients. Including CPE, WCC, sick visits, medication reviews, aiding in necessary referrals.
