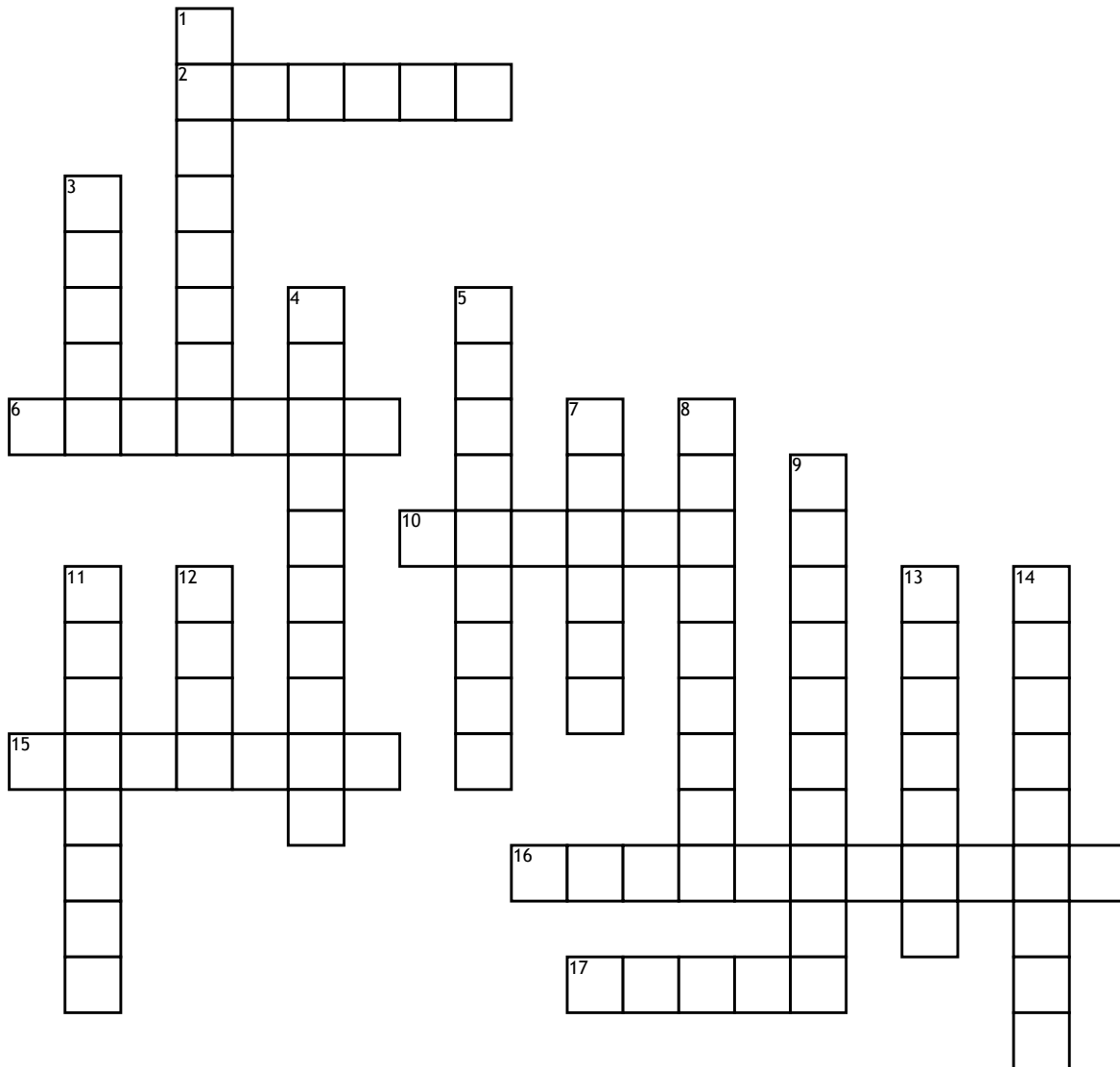


Principles of Hair Design



Across

- 2. press that removes 60 to 75% of curl
- 6. determined by the number of hair strands per square inch
- 10. curls positioned vertically
- 15. creates a flow or sense of consistency through the entire hair design
- 16. "C" shapes placed in alternating directions
- 17. a form of hairstyling where hairs have grown and intertwined

Down

- 1. also known as the focal point
- 3. The area within or surrounding a hair design
- 4. technique, where wet hair is designed into a specific shape
- 5. also known as carved curls, remain close to the head
- 7. lines that create softness, movement and waves within a design

- 8. provides the support, texture and movement of your final design
- 9. Flat pincurls that follow the fingerwave's ridge
- 11. Profile in which forehead, nose and chin align
- 12. a combination of lines that outline a shape
- 13. Protectant applied prior to using heat appliance as a protective barrier
- 14. a non-mirror image with unequal distribution of weight
