

- **2.** A sheet of any material prepared to be inked in order to make prints
- **4.** A type of relief print in which the image is cut into a piece of linoleum
- **8.** A tool for cutting and clearing areas from a block of wood or linoleum
- **9.** A device used to produce prints one copy at a time. It applies pressure between a sheet of paper and an inked surface
- 11. A round, smooth pad used to press paper against an inked wood or linoleum block. Can also use a wooden spoon.
- **12.** Metal or wooden plate with a raised lip on each edge to hold a wood or linoleum block in place while cutting

- 1. A printmaking process which uses the same block to print all of the colors, involves gradually carving down the block after each color is printed
- **3.** When printing multiple colors, the adjustment of the block to ensure correct alignment of colors
- **5.** The artist thought to be the inventor of reduction linoleum printing
- **6.** A technique in which the image is printed from raised areas on the printing plate
- **7.** A set of identical prints that are numbered and signed
- **10.** A small roller used to spread printing ink evenly on a surface before printing
