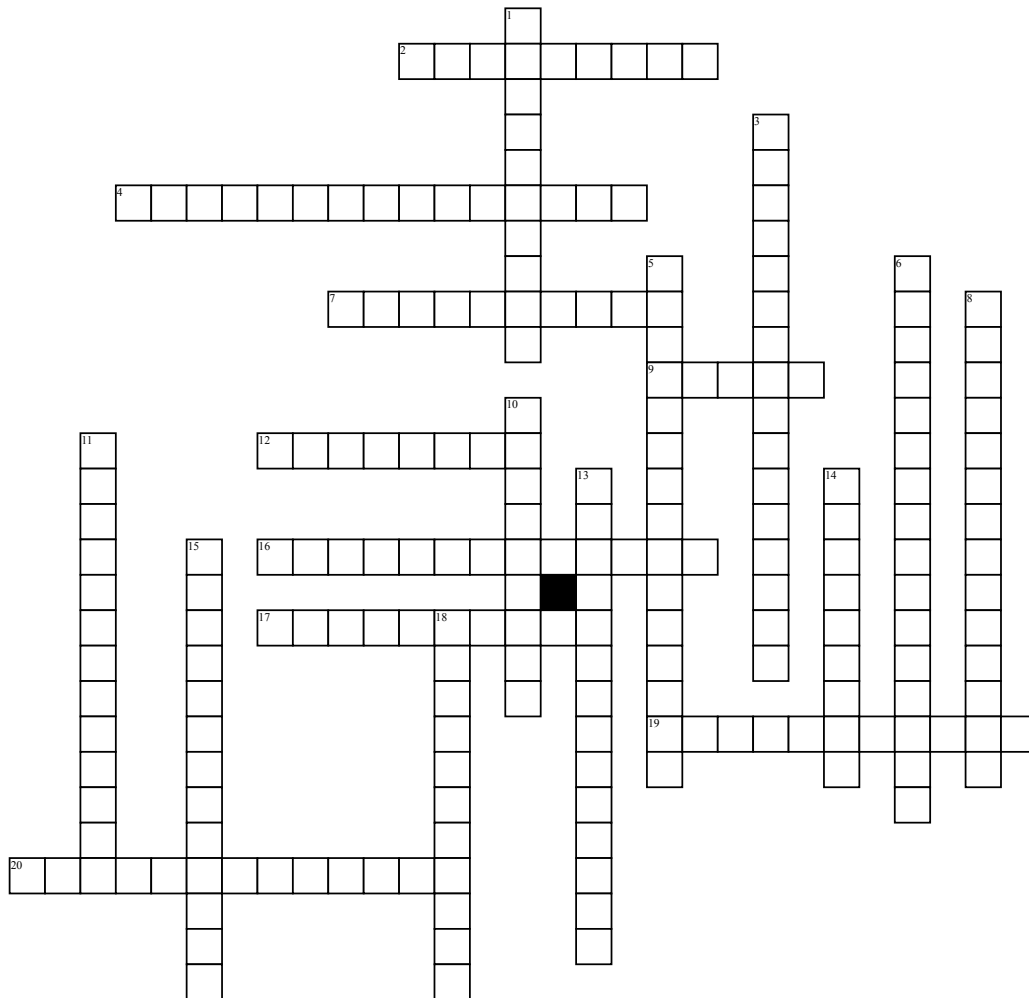


# Progressive Era
