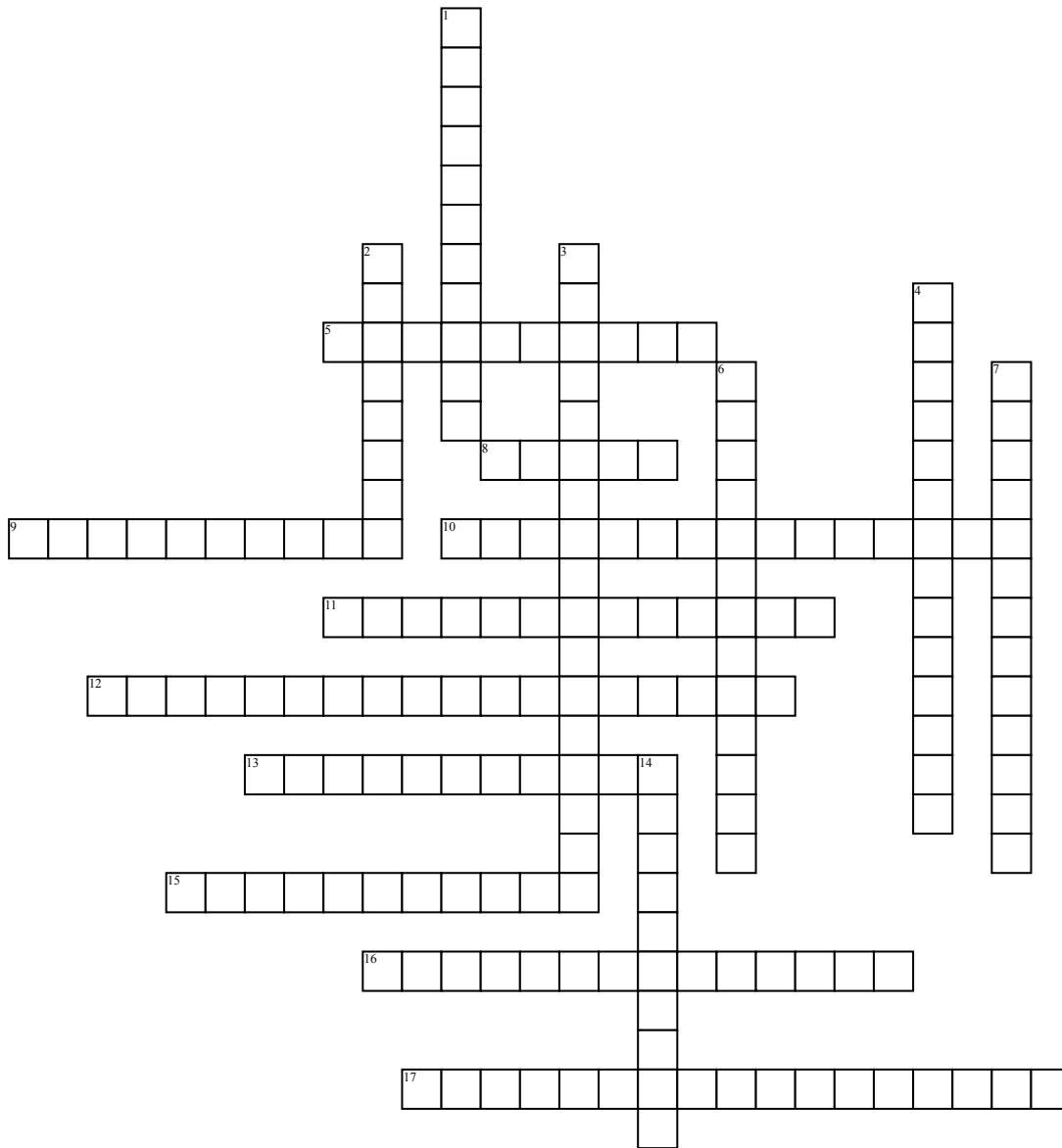

- 5.** co-founded one of the first settlements in the United States, the Hull House in Chicago, Illinois, and was named a co-winner of the 1931 Nobel Peace Prize.
8. Founded to abolish segregation and discrimination and to achieve political and civil rights for African Americans
9. uncovered and exposed misconduct in politics and business
10. Belief that assimilating immigrants into American society would make them more loyal citizens
11. Movement that responded to the pressures of industrialization and urbanization by promoting reforms

- 12.** Law that allowed federal inspection of food and medicine, banned the interstate shipment and sale of impure foods, and mislabeling of food and drugs
13. This provided for election of two U.S. Senators from each state by popular vote and for a term of six years
15. Gives Congress the power to enforce taxes on incomes
16. American statement that the government did not want colonies in China, but favored free trade there instead
17. A policy of creating and using, when necessary, a strong military to achieve America's goals
