


Properties of Everyday Mixtures (AR-2016)

- 3. two or more substances that are put together to form a single substance
- 4. the ability of a substance to resist going through a chemical change
- 5. made of up two or more elements that are chemically combined
- 6. it means 'putting together'
- 8. a property that describes a substance by itself such as color, shape, density or hardness

- 9. a single substance breaks up, forming two or more different substances
- 10. can be separated; no chemical change; each element keeps its own properties

- 1. the amount of mass something has in relation to its volume
- 2. a property that involves the ability of a substance to react with other materials & form new substances
- 7. compound made up of 2 molecules of hydrogen & 1 molecule of oxygen
