
## Properties of the Hair and Scalp



## **Across**

- **3.** A fibrous protein that grows from cells originating within the hair follicle
- 6. The innermost layer of the hair
- **7.** Small, involuntary muscle in the bas of the hair follicle
- **8.** Oil glands in the skin that are connected to the hair follicles
- **10.** A small, cone shaped elevation located at the base of the hair follicle that fits into the hair bulb

## <u>Down</u>

- 1. This is the outermost layer of the hair
- 2. Process by which newly formed cells in the hair bulb mature, fill with keratin, move upward, lose their nucleus, and die
- **4.** A tube-like depression or pocket in the skin or scalp that contains the hair root
- **5.** Lowest part of the hair strand and is the thickened, club-shaped structure that forms the lower part of the hair root.
- 9. The middle layer of the hair
