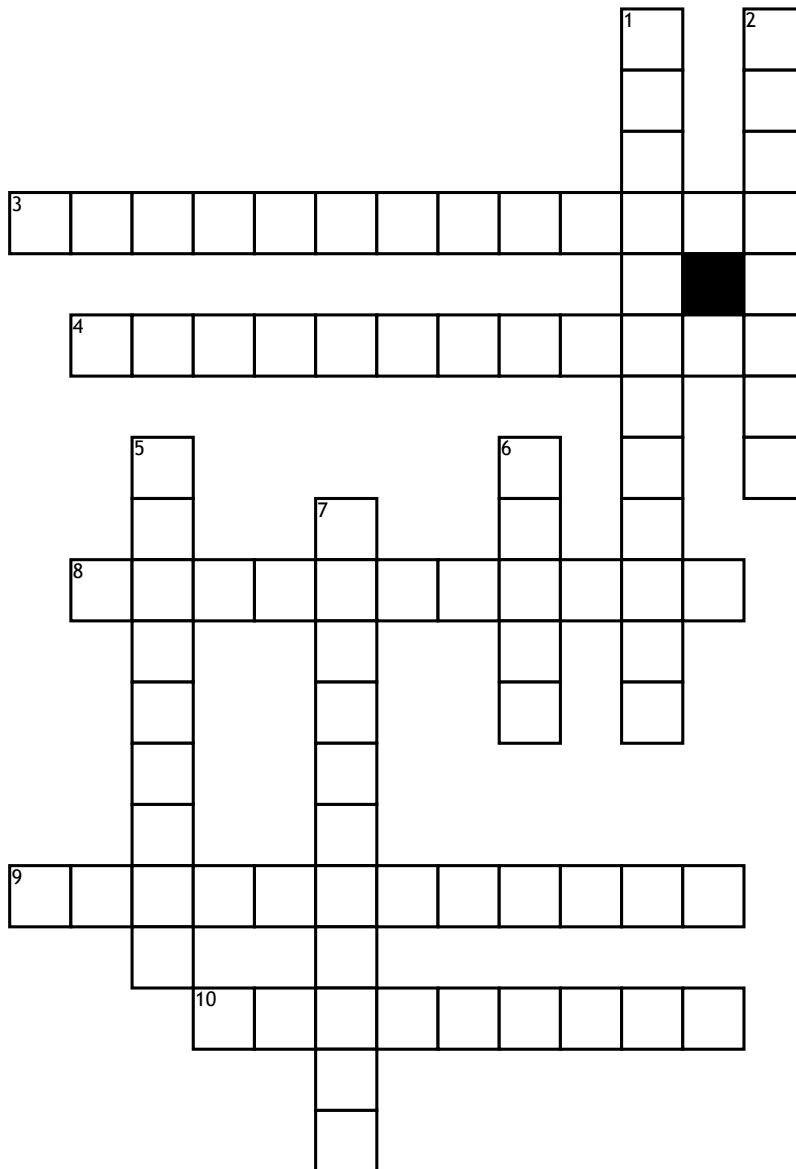


# Psychologists and Philosophers
