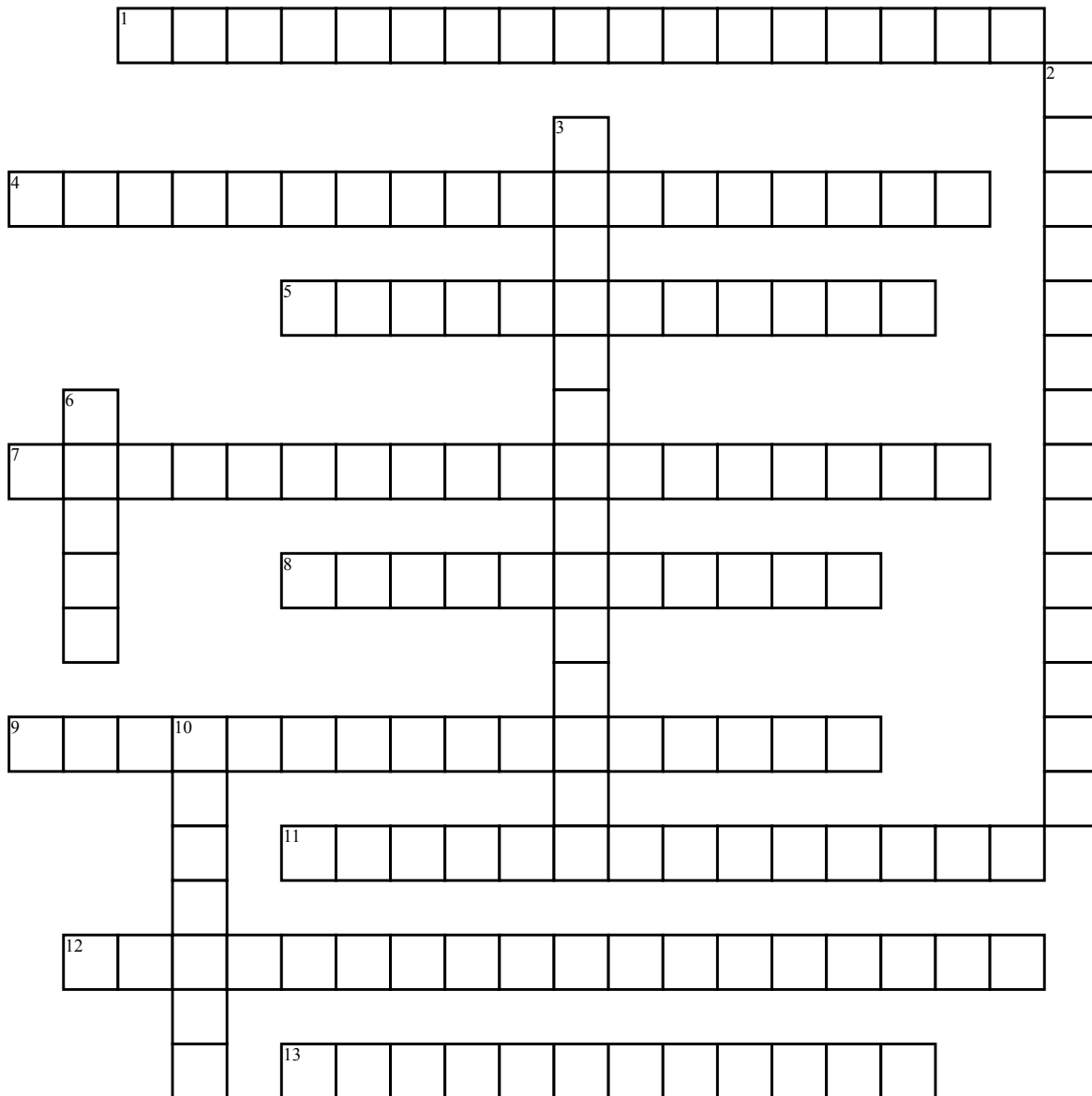

1. Learning to avoid events associated with aversive consequence
4. Exhibiting a behavior similar to that shown by a model in an unfamiliar situation
5. Program that motivates socially desirable behavior by reinforcing it with tokens exchangeable for desired things
7. Decrease in behavior that results from an added consequence

8. Use of sensitive equipment to give people precise feedback about internal psychological processes

9. Suppressing a behavior because a model is punished for it
11. Learning that occurs without apparent reinforcement and is not demonstrated until the organism is motivated to do so
12. Decrease in behavior from removed consequence
13. Mental representation of a spatial arrangement such as a maze

3. Learning a new behavior from a model through new responses
