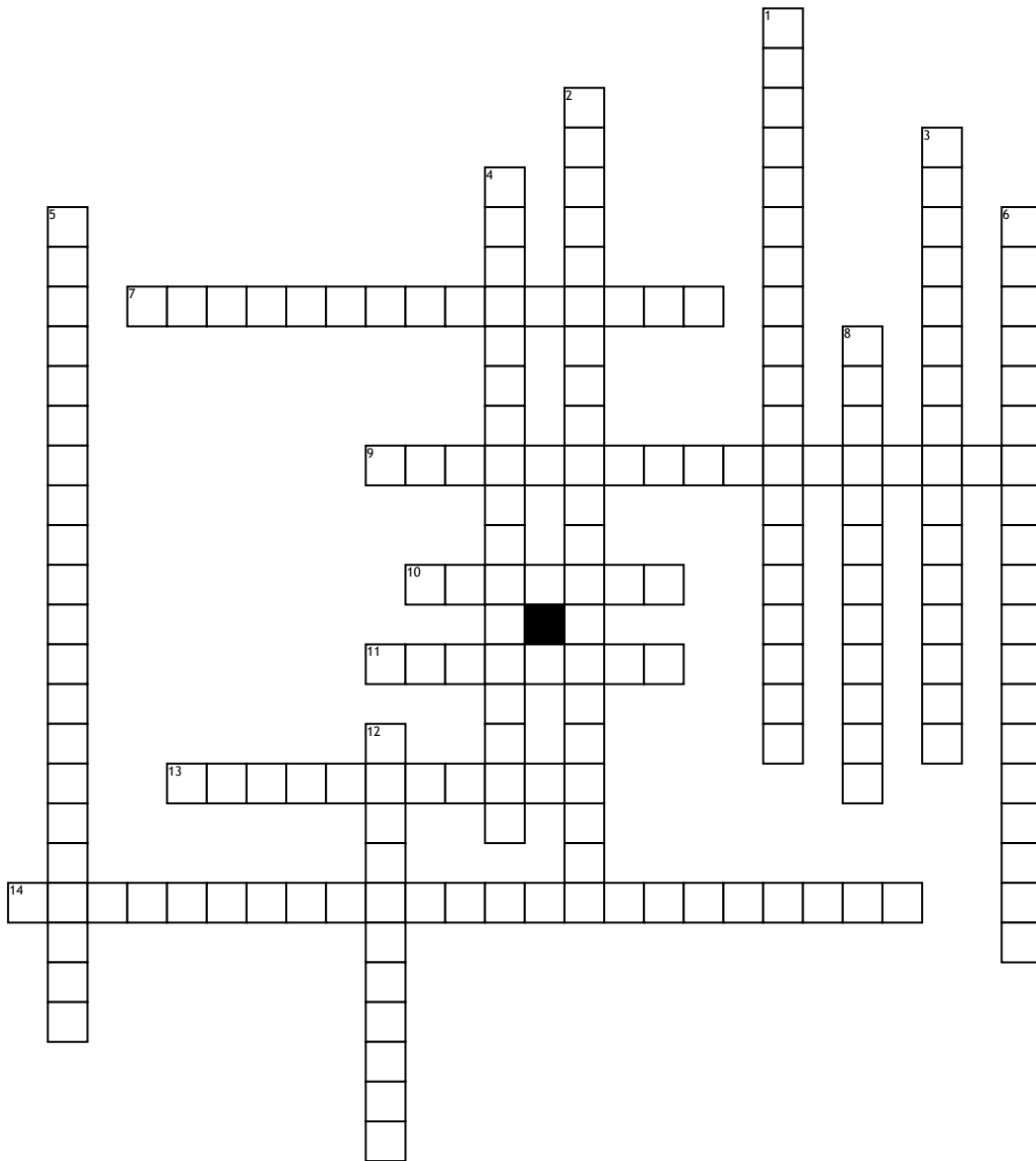

14. the condition that exists when the probability that the observed findings are due to chance is less than 1 in 20

1. factor that cause differences between the experimental group and the control group other than the independent variable

2. a description of the specific procedure used to determine the presence of a variable

3. research design in which participants don't know whether they are in the experimental or control group

4. the behavior or mental process that is measured in an experiment or quasi-experiment (effect)

5. clues participants discover about the purpose of the study that suggest how they should respond

6. the factor the researcher manipulates in a controlled experiment (cause)
