

- **12.** either of the two soft, protruding organs on the upper front of a woman's body which secrete milk after childbirth.

- 1. A wrinkled sack of skin that holds and protects the testes.
- 3. the final section of the large intestine, terminating at the anus.
- **4.** The tube that carries the sperm from the testicle.
- **5.** the small projection in which the mammary ducts of female mammals terminate and from which milk can be secreted.
- **6.** a muscular membranous sac in the abdomen which receives urine from the kidneys and stores it for excretion.
- **7.** Known to contain the egg needed for fertilisation.
- **8.** the muscular tube leading from the external genitals to the cervix of the uterus in women and most female mammals.
