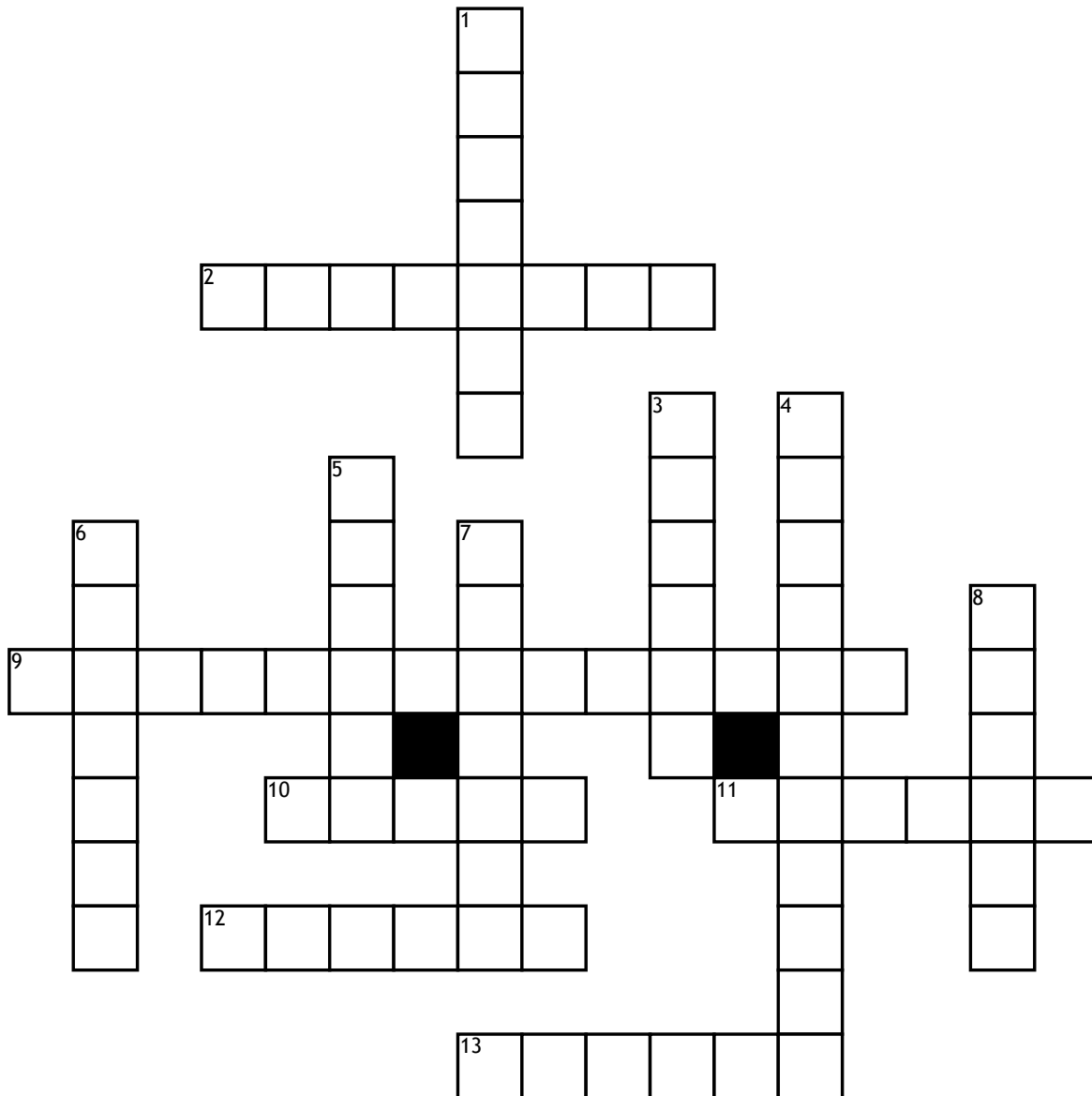

1. A wrinkled sack of skin that holds and protects the testes.

3. the final section of the large intestine, terminating at the anus.

4. The tube that carries the sperm from the testicle.

5. the small projection in which the mammary ducts of female mammals terminate and from which milk can be secreted.

6. a muscular membranous sac in the abdomen which receives urine from the kidneys and stores it for excretion.

7. Known to contain the egg needed for fertilisation.

8. the muscular tube leading from the external genitals to the cervix of the uterus in women and most female mammals.
