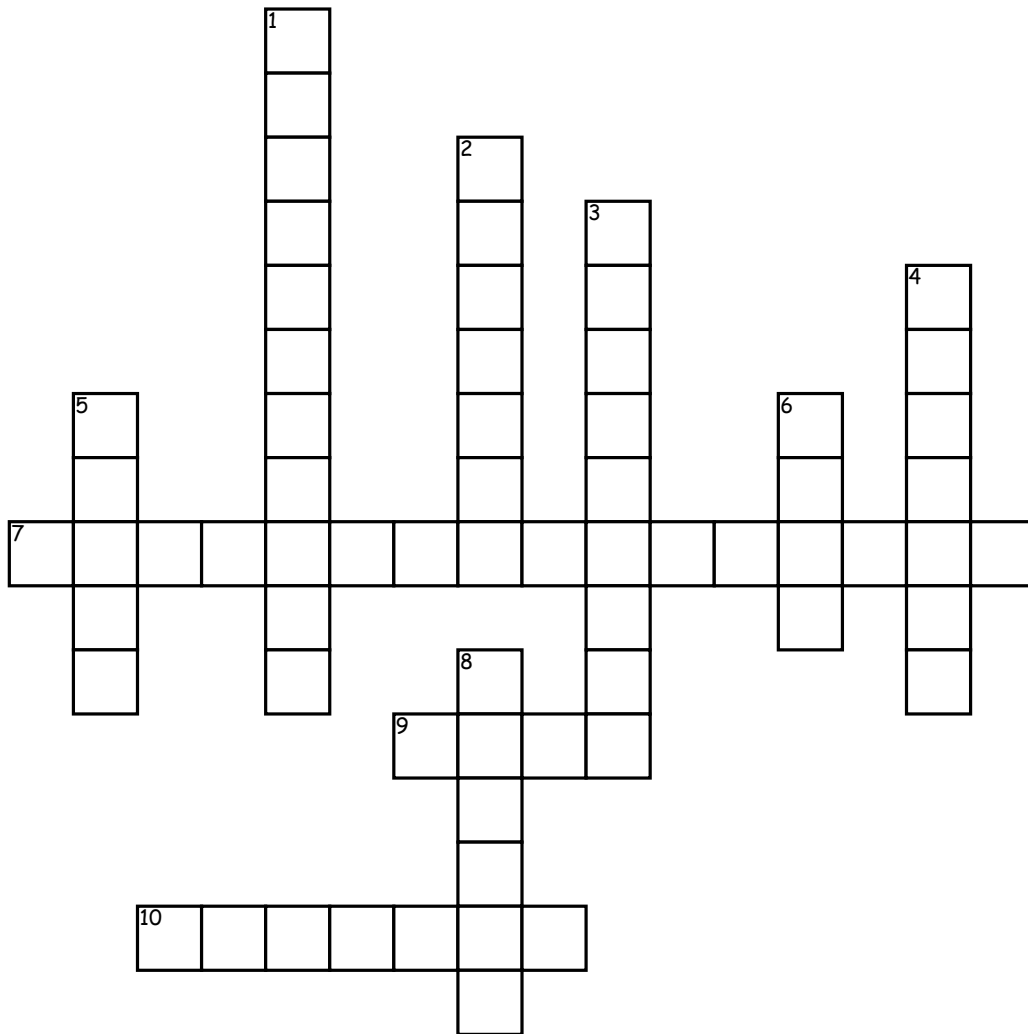


# Q1 Poetry Crossword by Xavier Wynne
