

- **9.** Fallopian tube; tube that carries eggs from an ovary to the uterus
- **11.** fluid-filled sac that cushions and protects a developing fetus
- **12.** A human embryo after eight weeks of development
- **14.** Fusion of male and female gametes.
- **16.** The process of releasing a mature ovum into the fallopian tube each month
- 18. Sex cells
- **20.** Long, narrow tube carrying sperm from the testes to the urethra

- **21.** The lining of the uterus, along with blood and the unfertilized ovum, is discharged through the vagina.
- 23. Female organs that release eggs
- 1. Connects the EMBRYO to placenta
- **2.** A muscular ring that separates the uterus and the vagina
- **3.** Cycle during which an egg develops and is released from an ovary and the uterus is prepared to receive a fertilized egg.
- **4.** A mass of tissue that is attached to the wall of the uterus and connected to the developing fetus by the umbilical cord
- 6. Birth canal, it receives the sperm

- **7.** Developmental stage at which a person becomes capable of reproduction.
- **8.** An organism in the earliest stage of development
- **10.** External sac that contains the testes
- 13. Mixture of sperm and seminal fluid
