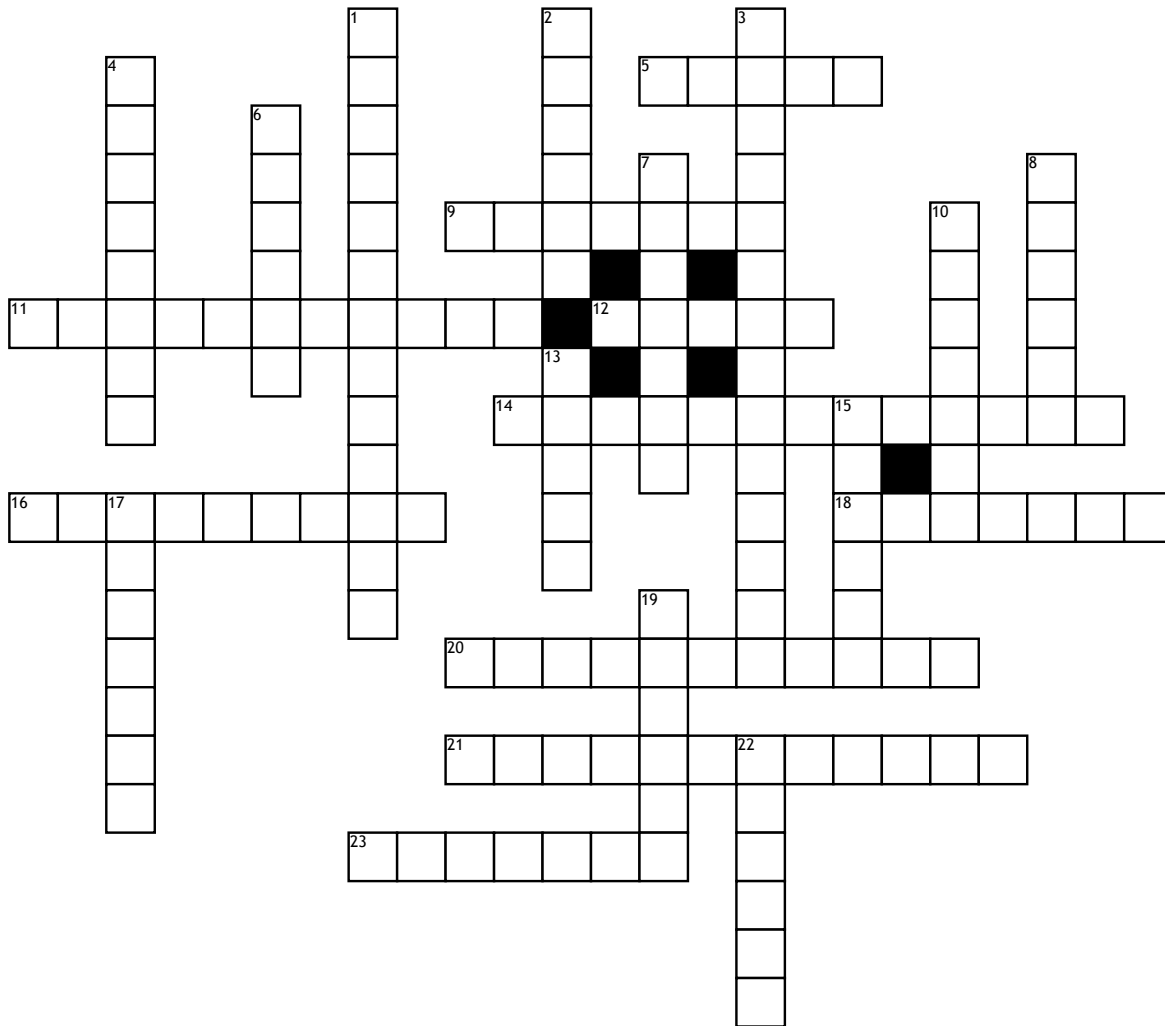

 11. fluid-filled sac that cushions and protects a developing fetus

 20. Long, narrow tube carrying sperm from the testes to the urethra

23. Female organs that release eggs

1. Connects the EMBRYO to placenta
 2. A muscular ring that separates the uterus and the vagina
 3. Cycle during which an egg develops and is released from an ovary and the uterus is prepared to receive a fertilized egg.
 4. A mass of tissue that is attached to the wall of the uterus and connected to the developing fetus by the umbilical cord
 6. Birth canal, it receives the sperm

7. Developmental stage at which a person becomes capable of reproduction.
