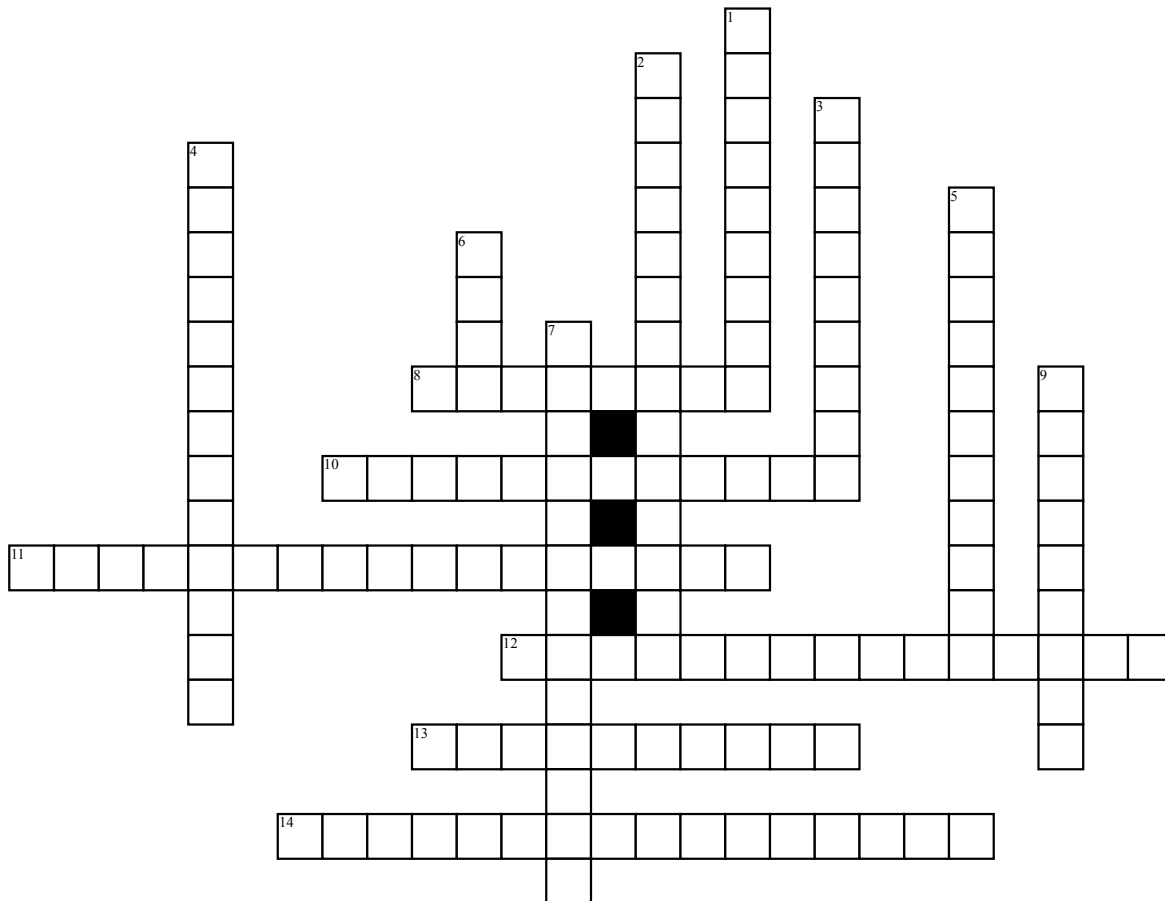

6. The socially defined classification of people based on certain physical characteristics.

7. The group that has the greatest power but not necessarily the greatest numbers.
