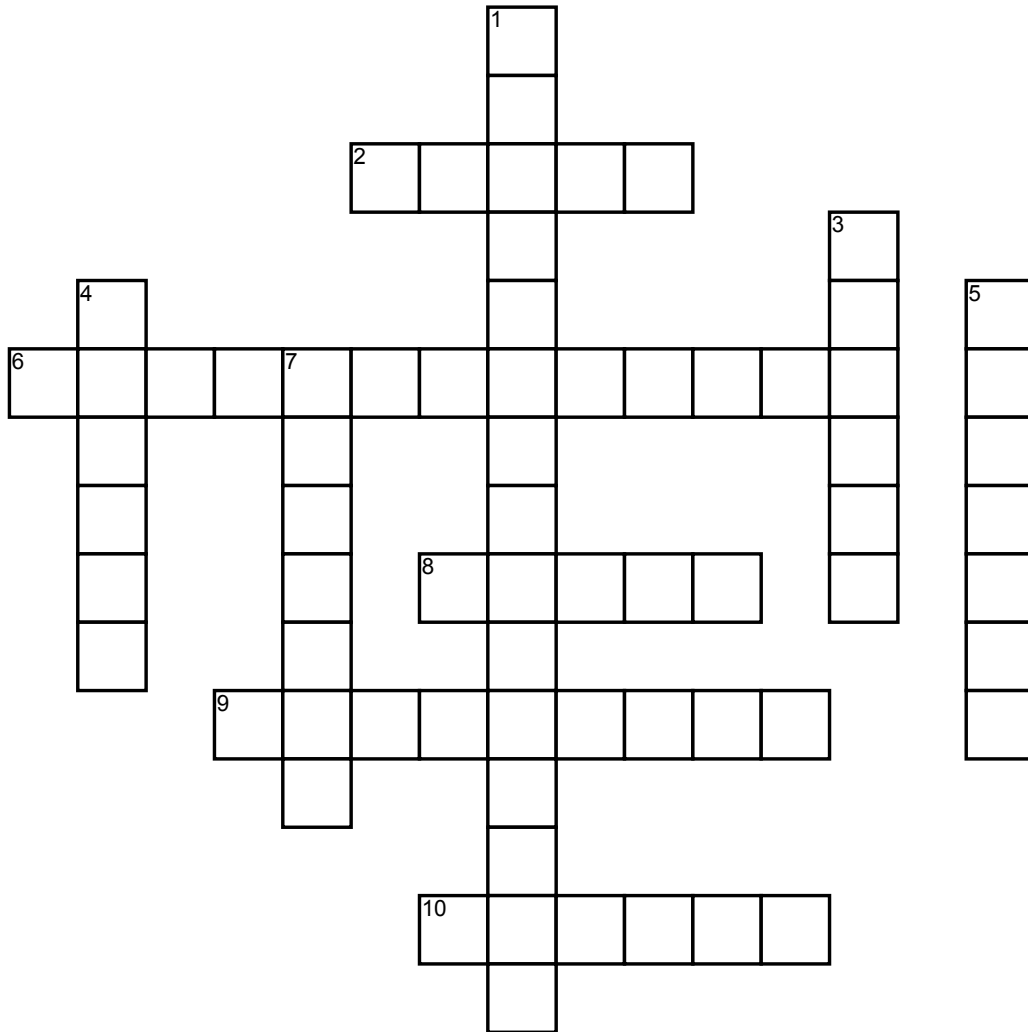


Re- productive organs in Human Body

2. males: can fertilise a female egg when released during sexual intercourse.
 6. female: passage which eggs travel from the ovaries to uterus.
 8. males: used for depositing of urine and delivering sperm cells to the vagina during sexual intercourse
 9. males: produces testosterone and sperm
 10. female: has a small narrow entrance and is used to flow menstrual blood and direct sperm

Down

1. males: sperm storage area
 3. female: known as the womb. Is a main female hormone responsive organ.
 4. female: a main tube going from the vulva to the cervix.
 5. males: pouch of skin containing testicles
 7. female: trigger major hormone (estrogen) , also produce one egg, per month.
