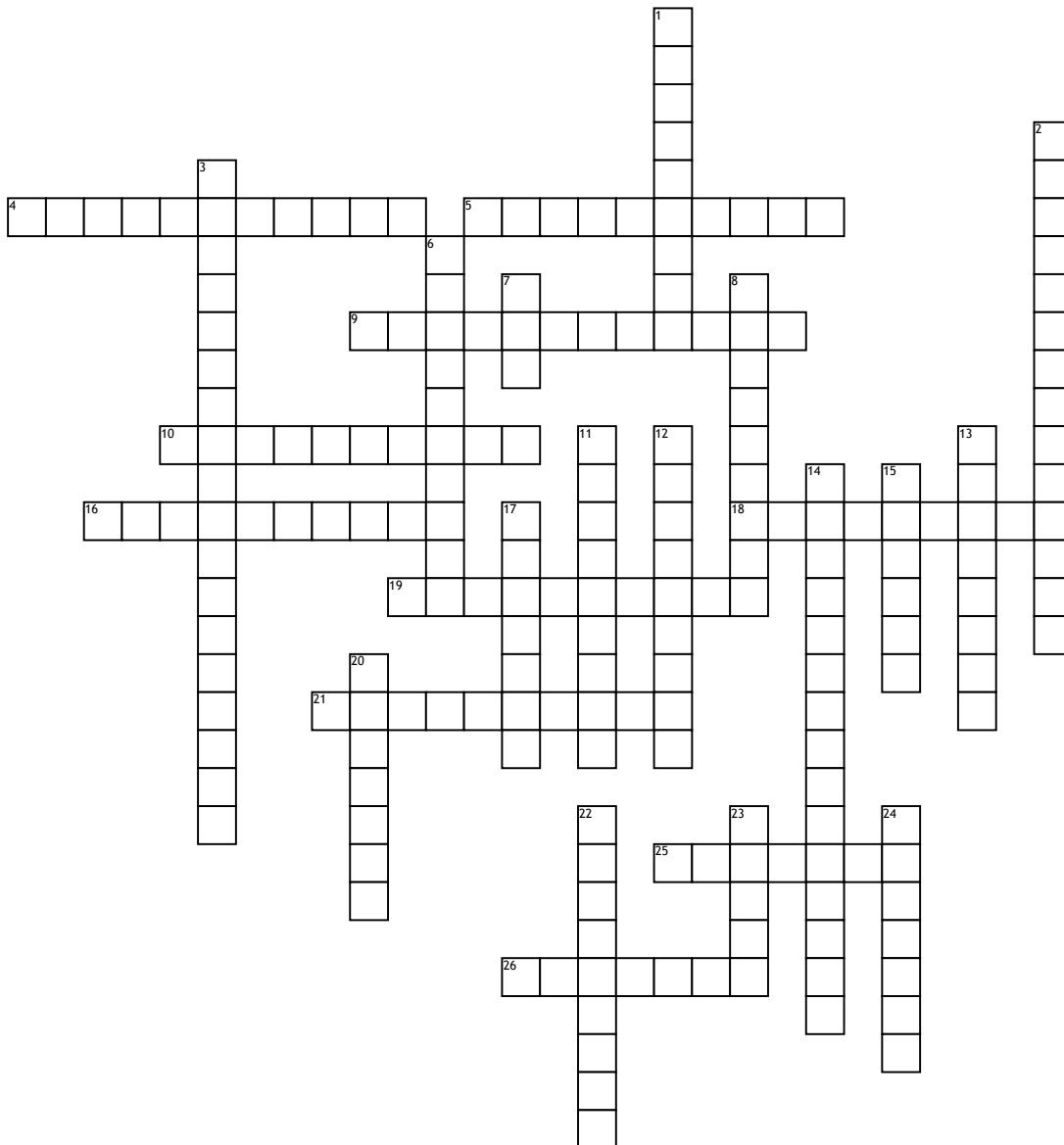


Reconciliation/Eucharist

1. sacrament in which we receive the Body and Blood of Christ in the form of bread and wine
