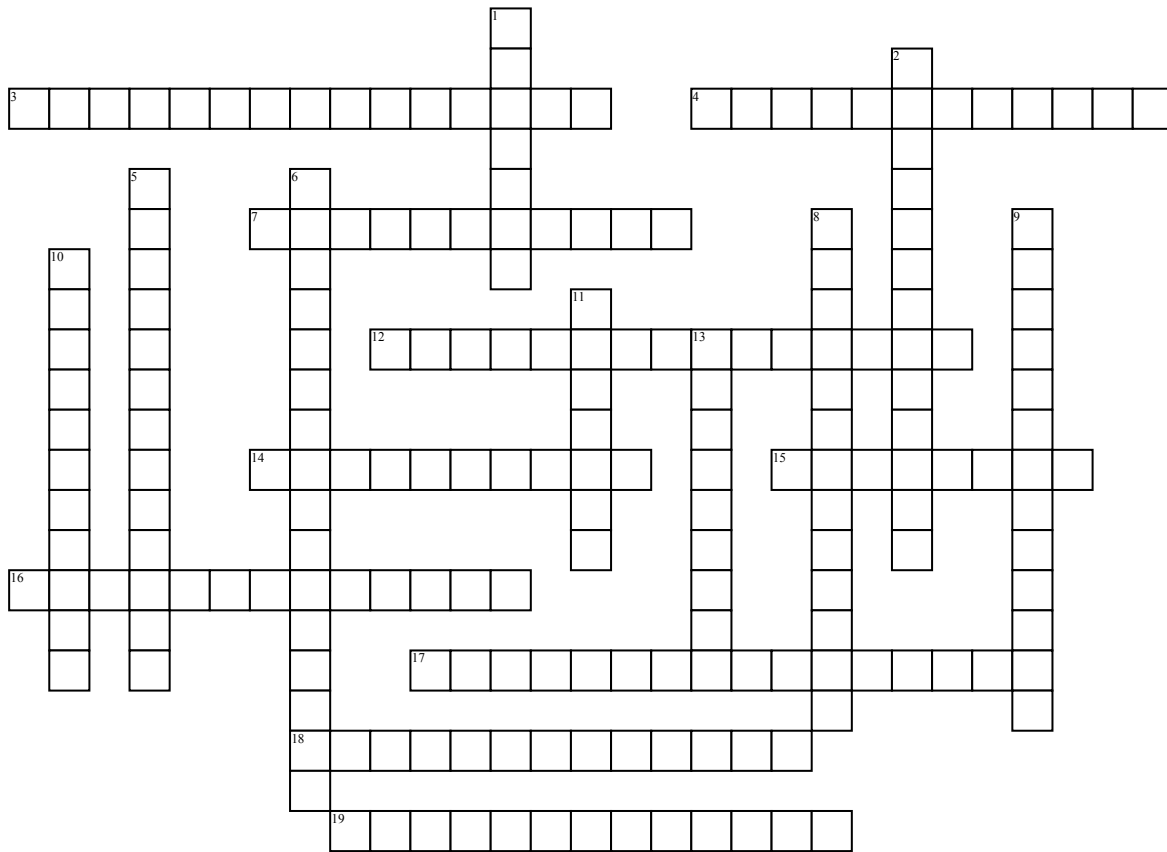


# Reconstruction Era Crossword
