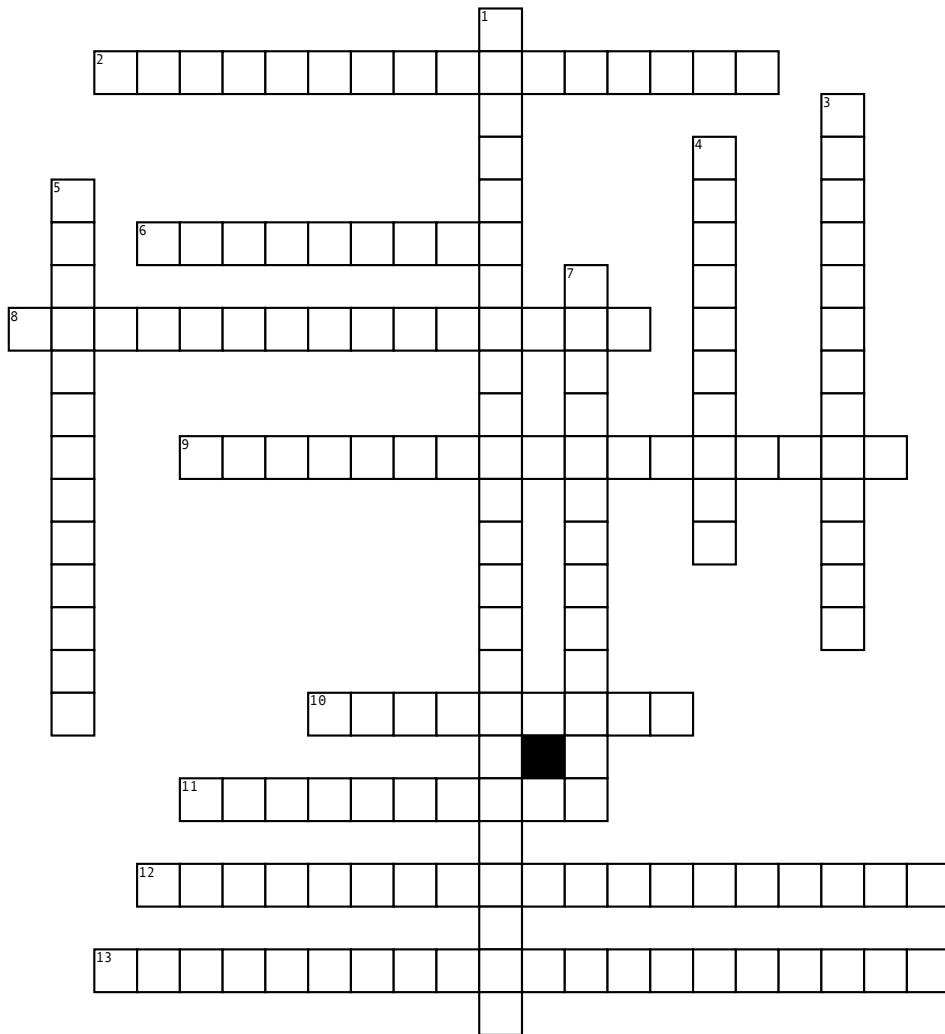


# Reconstruction Era Terms

- 1. #13, 14, 15 added to the constitution in 1865 and 1870, the 5 years directly after the civil war.

- 3. A bill proposed for the reconstruction of the south
- 4. White supremacists that killed people who they opposed, including white people, carpetbaggers, and scalawags
- 5. A tenant farmer who worked in exchange for seed, tools, living quarters, and food.
- 7. A northerner who moved to the South after the civil war usually seeking private gin under the reconstruction governments.
