

Regions of The Brain

- **3.** lobe dealing with voluntary motor function, mood, and smell
- 7. made of two hemispheres with convoluted surfaces
- **8.** part of diencephalon located under thalamus caping the brainstem. Main visceral control center, important to homeostasis
- **10.** lobe dealing with integration of visual input
- **11.** composed mostly of tracts of nerve fibers

- **12.** sorting, editing, and crude recognition of sensation part of the diencephalon
- **13.** layer of cerebrum known as white matter, myelinated nerve tracts
- **14.** layer of cerebrum with grey matter and no myelin sheath

Down

- 1. inferior and merges into spinal chord
- **2.** internal island of grey matter in inferior cerebrum, diencephalon, and midbrain

- **4.** lobe dealing with olfactory and auditory input, memory, and judgment
- **5.** lobe dealing with reception and evaluation of sensory info EXCEPT smell, hearing, and vision
- **6.** part if diencephalon that houses the pineal gland
- **9.** involved in control of breathing
