

23. This is the most important prayer of the church

1. the priest blesses us in the name of the Father the Son and the Holy Spirit
3. The altar is prepared by the Deacon and the Altar servers

5. Gathered in Gods presence the assembly sees its sinfulness and proclaims the mystery of Gods love
7. We say aloud or sing the lamb of God asking Jesus for his mercy, forgiveness, and peace.
11. The deacon or priest proclaims a reading from the \_\_\_\_\_ of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John
12. On some Sundays we sing or say this ancient hymn
13. The priest offers the final prayer
14. we stand to sing \_\_\_\_\_ or the other words of praise
16. This prayer expresses the theme of the celebration and the needs and hopes of the assembly
