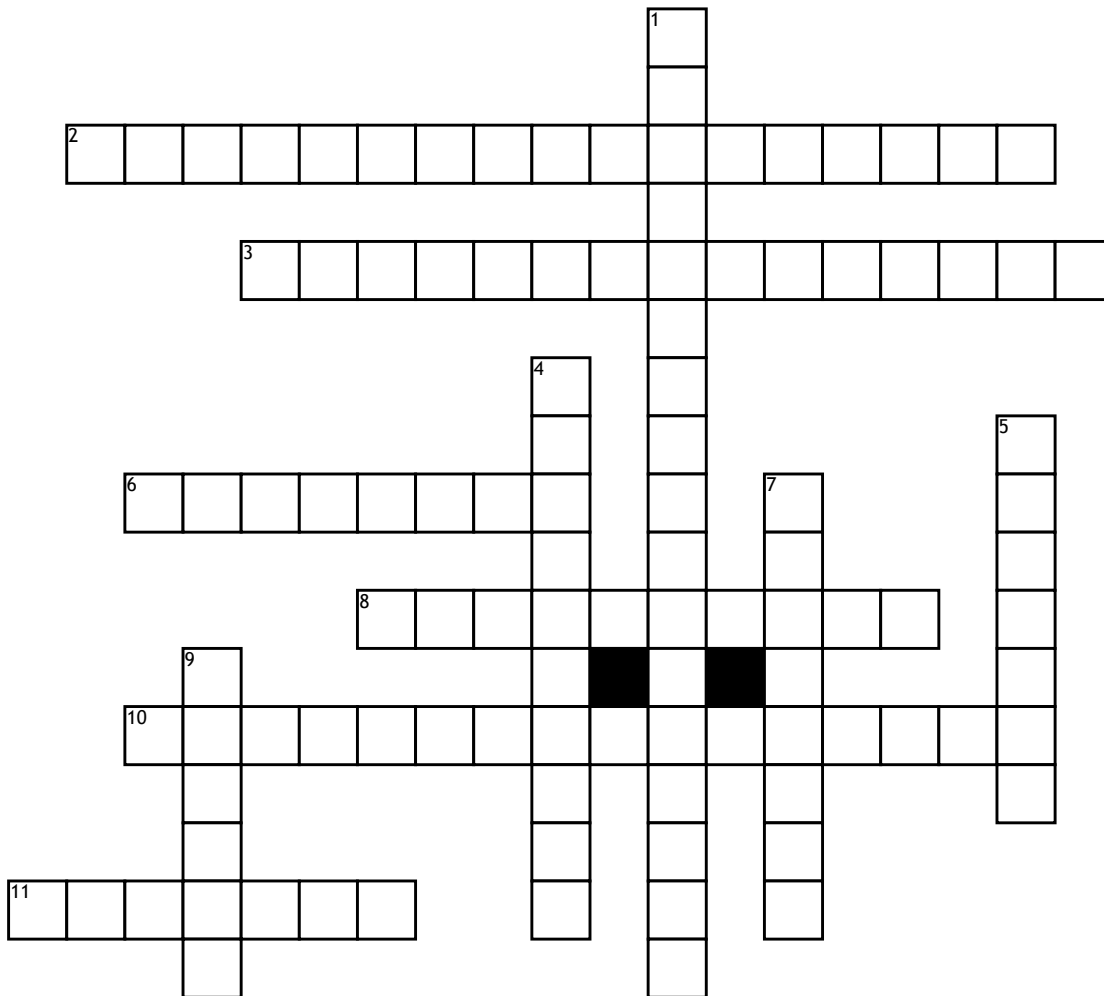


Renaissance Weaponry, Military, and the Spanish Armada
