
Renal Dysfunction

- 3. oliguria, periorbital edema, hypertension, hematuria, proteinuria
- 4. proteinuria, hypoalbuminemia, hyperlipidemia, edema, normal to 21. inflammation or infection of low bp
- **6.** imaging of the bladder
- **9.** flank bruising from renal trauma,
- **13.** narrowed opening of foreskin that can't retract
- **14.** lab value 6, 20mg/dL
- 15. urethral opening on dorsal aspect of penis

- 16. sudden onset oliguria, metabolic acidosis low Ca, high K,
- **17.** undescended testicle
- 20. infection with fever, flank pain, increased WBC
- phimotic foreskin
- **22.** urination at night
- 23. requires vascular access to filter
- **24.** lab value 0.5, 1.2mg/dL Down
- 1. AKI, hemolytic anemia, thrombocytopenia

- 2. ultrasound to break up kidney stones,
- 5. urine backs up into ureters while voiding
- 7. fluid instilled in abdominal cavity to filter blood,
- 8. urine incontinence in potty trained child
- 10. kidney stone
- 11. urethral opening on underside of penis
- **12.** bladder is outside body
- **18.** med to stop bladder spasms
- 19. peritoneal fluid in scrotum
